SCRIPTURE EXODUS: 15:22-16:36

### PROVISION OF ASSURANCE (EX 15:22-27)

Three days from the crossing of the Red Sea the Israelites are already Complaining because they are thirsty. "Marah" means Bitter, which describes the water and the attitude of the Israelites. God demonstrates a Sweet Assurance to the Israelites, even with their grumbling.

### PROVISION OF DAILY NEED (EX 16:1-5)

The second time we read of the grumbling of the Israelites is about Five weeks from when they first grumbled. They have nothing left to eat. This event shifts the complaint of the Israelites from Moses and Aaron to the divine character of God. This reveals the Heart of the Israelites, and our own.

### PROVISION OF IMMEDIATE NEED (EX 16:6-15)

Because the daily need was promised for the next morning, God provided Quail for the immediate need of hunger that evening. God's grace abound to us in our human weakness.

### PROVISION OF OPPORTUNITY FOR OBEDIENCE (EX 16:16-36)

The instructions regarding the gathering of the bread establish a test and framework of Israel's willingness to Obey God's commands and Trust in His daily provision. The detailed instructions regarding collection for the Sabbath were entirely NEW. This is the first mention of a Sabbath observance for the Israelites. This signified Dependence on God, Obedience to Him, and a special Relationship with Him.

### CONCLUSION

This passage demonstrates the importance of gratitude and of our reliance on God. We need to remember His past provision, we need not be envious of what others have, instead, we are to trust fully in God's goodness and timing.

When we acknowledge Jesus' life and sacrifice as the ultimate provision and remembrance of God's faithfulness. It reinforces God's call to trust, remember, and obey His instructions.
