INTRODUCTION EXODUS 25-31

We have been following the Israelites journey since the crossing of the Red Sea to escape the Egyptians. Much has occurred in the short time of traversing the WILDERNESS.

### 1. GOD'S INVITATION TO WORSHIP (EX 25:1-9)

This reinforces the fact that it is God's desire to DWELL among His people. Ultimately this is fully realized in Christ, and how He now DWELLS in us as the fulfillment of God's plan for INTIMATE worship. Our bodies are now the dwelling place - the TABERNACLE - of God.

### 2. DESIGN WITH DIVINE PURPOSE (EX 25-31)

PRECISENESS spans every aspect of these designs. This beautifully detailed tabernacle required an INTENTIONALITY in its construction. God prescribed the means necessary in great detail to create a space that true worshippers could enter in and offer AUTHENTIC worship. This earthly tabernacle was designed to reflect God's GLORY.

Our worship should aim to REFLECT Christ's beauty and holiness for we are all also designed with divine purpose.

### 3. SACRIFICE: THE HEART OF WORSHIP (EX 27:1-8)

All of the detail and preciseness of the laws of the burnt offerings were designed to once again DIFFERENTIATE Israel from other nations. God was calling a people unto Himself and that calling creates a DISTINCTION between those called and those that are "outside the commonwealth of Israel". The vivid focus on sacrifice was the HEARTBEAT of the Israelites worship, and that vivid focus remains the HEARTBEAT of the Church's worship.

### 4. SET APART FOR SERVICE (EX 28-31)

In Exodus 28-30 we read of the details involving the PRIESTHOOD of Israel. In Exodus 31:1-11 we read of the calling of the Spirit-led craftsman that God called by name to use their GIFTS in worship to God. EVERY believer in the Church has been consecrated unto God. Within this organization EACH person has a gifting and a service. The individuals in the Church collectively REFLECT the manifest glory of God through our service to Him.

CONCLUSION

Our challenge today is to not just understand the parallels of that which has been described for us in Exodus, but to fully understand and apply the underlying meanings.
