People are known by what they say, what they do, and what others say about them.

What people say...

“Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.” — Luke 23:34 → Forgiveness

“Truly I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.”
— Luke 23:43 → Assurance

““Woman, behold, your son!” Then He said to the disciple, “Behold, your mother!” — John 19:26 → Compassion

“My God, my God, why have you forsaken Me?” — Mark 15:34 → Loneliness

“I thirst.” — John 19:28 → Humanity

“It is finished.” — John 19:30 → Victory

“It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over the entire land until the ninth hour, because the sun stopped shining; and the veil of the temple was torn in two. What people do...

Matthew 27:50-53, “And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and gave up His spirit. And behold, the *veil of the temple was torn* in two from top to bottom; and the *earth shook* and the *rocks were split*. Also the *tombs were opened*, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection, they entered the holy city and appeared to many.

Hebrews 9:2-3, 6-7, “There were two rooms in that Tabernacle. In the first room were a lampstand, a table, and sacred loaves of bread on the table. This room was called the Holy Place. Then there was a curtain, and behind the curtain was the second room called the Most Holy Place. When these things were all in place, the priests regularly entered the first room as they performed their religious duties. But only the high priest ever entered the Most Holy Place, and only once a year. And he always offered blood for his own sins and for the sins the people had committed in ignorance.”

Jesus is the final High Priest.

The cross is the New Testament Mercy Seat.

Hebrews 9:22, “For without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness.”
