This guide is designed to assist you in creating a space for genuine connection and conversation within your Life Group. Don't feel pressured to address every question each week. Rather, allow the Holy Spirit to guide you as you lead your group in uncovering what God intends to communicate to you all.

LOVING

Dedicate the first few moments together to connecting and growing as a group (approx. 10-15 minutes). Go around the group, allowing enough space for each person to respond to at least one of these questions.

How can you pursue a joy that is deep and lasting, rather than fleeting and dependent on circumstances?

LIVING

This week, take intentional steps to embrace and reflect

the joy of Jesus. Read through Psalm 98:1-8 again and

reflect on what the author is feeling and communicating.

Then, identify areas in your life where joy seems fleeting
