Colossians 2:12-15 (ESV) ¹² having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead. ¹³ And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, ¹⁴ by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. ¹⁵ He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

1. Through Jesus Christ's death and resurrection we have new life!

<u>Colossians 2:12-13a (ESV)</u>¹² having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead. ¹³ And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him,

2. Through Jesus Christ's death and resurrection we have forgiveness of all our sins.

<u>Colossians 2:13b-14 (ESV)</u> having forgiven us all our trespasses, ¹⁴ by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.

3. Through Jesus Christ's death and resurrection we have victory over the forces of evil.

<u>Colossians 2:15 (ESV)</u> He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

Colossians 1:13-14 (ESV)¹³ He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
