“Peter Heals a Lame Beggar: We Will Do Greater Things” on February 7th and 10th

HOOK

- What is the worst pain you have ever felt?
- Share an experience when you prayed for someone to be healed.

BOOK

Acts 3:1-20

John 14:12

LOOK

- What does it mean that we will do greater things than Jesus?
- Why is that challenging for us?
- How can you and your group, as “the church”, reach out to your world?
- What does the world need?
- What does it mean that we will do greater things than Jesus?
- Why is that challenging for us?
- How will this convince them of God’s love?
- Who is the source of the great works we do?
- Why is this so important for us to remember?
- What is the purpose of healing according to Acts 3:17-19? (So they would turn towards God.)
- How does this qualify as a “greater work”?
- Knowing God is the healer how can we pray with confidence for those who are hurting?
- What’s our ultimate hope as a result of our prayers? (They would turn towards God.)

TOOK

- As a group or individual write out the name of a friend, family member or neighbor who is hurting.
- Put their names in a jar and bring them out each week as a reminder to pray for them that they would turn towards God and acknowledge him as Lord and Savior.

PRAY

- Praying for those loved ones who are hurting and need physical and spiritual healing
- Pray that God will give you faith to keep on praying regardless of the outcome.
- Pray that you be filled with the Holy Spirit to do greater works than Jesus in your lifetime.
