"Matthew 5:33-42" on May 24th

CONNECT

How did last week's passage we read/discussed from Matthew 5:27-32 affect your week?

DISCOVER - MATTHEW 5:27-32

What did the passage say or did you take away from the sermon this week? How does this passage/did this sermon point us to Jesus or teach us about Jesus?

God desires for citizens of His Kingdom to be His image-bearers; what the world sees in our lives and the life of the Church affects how they see God. Today we look at three things: Truth matters. Don't take revenge. Live generously

TRUTH MATTERS! Jesus instructs us to simply be truthful – always. Truth has become relative in our society; the culture of our family, business, team, and relationships will be based on how truthfully we lead them.

- Are you known as a person who keeps his/her word?
- What areas of your life as a follower of Jesus would you like to see God strengthen?
- What can other people determine about truth in your life?
- How are the choices you are making reflecting your citizenship in Gods kingdom?

In Scripture, both God and Jesus make promise after promise to us - promises with eternal rewards!

- What promises of Jesus stand out most to you?
- How do the promises of Jesus sustain you?

DON'T TAKE REVENGE OR RETALIATE! God alone is in charge of administrating justice.

- When you feel you have been wronged, how equipped are you to GIVE mercy and justice rather than receive it? How could this impact the content of your prayers?
- How is it difficult to be God's image-bearer when you've been wronged?
- What is your greatest challenge to depend on God's justice, not your own?

LIVE GENEROUSLY! Jesus instructs us to 'walk the second mile' as His image-bearers.

- What does this look like for citizens of God's Kingdom?
- How willing are you to do whatever it takes to show who Jesus is and what it looks like to follow Him in your everyday life?
- What practical steps can you intentionally take to go the second mile in relationships that might be difficult?

OF THESE THREE: Truth matters. Don't take revenge. Live generously.

Which means the most to you, and why?

RESPOND

What changes could you make this week to increase your dependence on Jesus?

Who is someone you can have a conversation with about what Jesus is doing in your life or invite to join you as you watch CU Church online next week?
