“Daniel 6” on February 20<sup>nd</sup> and February 23<sup>rd</sup>

### DISCOVER: DANIEL 6 – WHAT ARE THE LIONS IN YOUR LIFE?

- What did the passage say or did you take away from the sermon this week?
- How does this passage/did this sermon point us to Jesus or teach us about Jesus?

### THE SITUATION

Daniel found himself in a situation in which he would have to compromise his belief in God to obey King Darius’ edict. As a faithful follower of God, he TRUSTED God to transform his dangerous situation! As a result, Daniel impacted his culture, giving glory to God.

- Is there a situation in your life that are you holding on to that you need to give to God and allow Him to change?
- What holds you back from trusting God completely to transform your situation, and how could your group pray for you?

### CONVICTION

Daniel was driven by his conviction to honor and please God no matter what his situation was, and he ACTED on that conviction in faith, trusting God with the outcome.

- Is there something in your life that stands between your DESIRE to honor God and the decision to ACT on your conviction?
- What lessons do you learn from the way Daniel approached his situation?

### HABITS

Daniel was convicted to honor God above all else, and he developed HABITS, especially in his prayer life, that led him to intimacy with God.

- What habits have you established in our life, and where do they lead you?

### END OF THE STORY

Because of Daniel’s faithfulness to his convictions and because of the habits he faithfully followed, God blessed him with visions of Jesus’ 1st and 2nd comings, and of heaven coming to earth!

- What does faithful living in anticipation of Jesus’ return look like in your life?
- How does knowing ‘The End of the Story’ encourage you and anchor you?

### RESPOND

Who is someone you can have a conversation with about what Jesus is doing in your life or invite to join you at CU?

### PRAY

End your group this week praying for each other and praising God. Pray that he will show you how to better love God and love people.
