As a church, we are committed to doing whatever it takes to help people find and follow God. I'm excited to be going on this journey alongside each of you. WE ARE MADE FOR **MORE**.



THE THREE PIECES OF MADE FOR MORE

1. MORE THROUGH MOBILIZATION » \$500K

In order for us to live out our mission and vision, we are increasing our operational budget. As we increase our budget, we are filtering every ministry decision we make through the lens of helping people go. We are asking the question, "Does this help us equip and send people into the places God has called them?" We are committed to do even **MORE** to equip and send people. This will allow us to grow in developing leaders, staffing, Kids on the Move, Movement Students, Move Groups, and Movement Celebrations in order to challenge, invite, equip, and send people out. We are MADE FOR **MORE**.

2. MORE IN OUR COMMUNITY » \$280K

We have taken significant steps over our first six years in order to impact our community. In this next season, we believe that God has even **MORE** for us. MADE FOR **MORE** will help us pursue a permanent facility that will let us do even **MORE** in our community. Our vision is not to have just a place to "go to church" on Sundays, but rather a facility that serves the community daily and is where Movement also meets for our celebrations. This facility will give us a physical presence in our community and provide creative ways to connect. This facility will give us more options and opportunities to accomplish the mission God has called us to.

3. MORE WITH PARTNERS » \$70K

Over our first six years as a church, we have worked hard to develop strategic, gospel-centered partnerships with other organizations built on prayer, relationships, and the common purpose of serving kids. We believe that God has even **MORE** He wants to do! One specific partnership we want to continue to build is with Lifeline Christian Mission's work in Guatemala. We want to provide funding for an additional staff person that will help the church in Guatemala move closer to multiplication. We are going to take a huge step forward in all of our partnerships in order to help **MORE** people find and follow God.

ONE MISSION. ONE FUND.

This initiative is much different than a traditional capital campaign. A traditional capital campaign focuses mostly on people who are already giving. These people are asked to continue giving what they currently are, as well as to start giving toward something else—like a building or special project. We aren't doing that through MADE FOR **MORE**. Instead, MADE FOR **MORE** will be a “one fund” initiative, meaning ALL of our giving goes toward ALL three critical components of this MADE FOR **MORE** journey. It's all one mission, so it's all one budget.

Why does this distinction matter? Simple. Because we want everyone at Movement to be transformed through the MADE FOR **MORE** initiative.

Through a “one fund” initiative we will more successfully invite everyone into asking, “What's the **MORE** God has for me?” We believe God is calling all of us to take a step of faith in the area of generosity, regardless of IF you currently give, or WHAT you currently give.

Every dollar given to Movement through 2021 will go directly to MADE FOR **MORE**, helping us do **MORE** through mobilization, **MORE** in our community, and **MORE** with partners.

THE **GENEROSITY** JOURNEY

1. **FIRST-TIME** GIVER

Someone who decides to give for the first time; someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift.

2. **CONSISTENT** GIVER

Someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis. This often requires planning, and sometimes this might be a reason for someone to set up recurring gifts online or to become disciplined with giving through regular envelopes or checks.

3. **INTENTIONAL** GIVER

Someone who begins asking the question, "Why am I giving more towards my cell phone bill than I'm giving to God?" This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they feel about it in relation to other things they spend their money on. This may also be the point of intentionality when someone begins to intentionally reflect on a certain amount or percentage they want to give to God.

4. **SURRENDERED** GIVER

Someone who begins to ask the questions, "Am I giving in a way that changes me? Am I giving in a way that causes my lifestyle to be different, reflecting the transformation Christ is making in me?" A Surrendered Giver's commitment to giving actually governs the rest of his or her lifestyle. A Surrendered Giver has a giving commitment that is "larger than their current situation" so that they have to adjust the rest of their finances to meet that commitment.

5. **LEGACY** GIVER

Someone who is no longer asking the question, "God, how much are you asking me to give?" A Legacy Giver is asking the question, "God, how much are you asking me to keep?" They ask this so that they can release the rest into Kingdom purposes. Much like a Surrendered Giver makes a commitment that will govern his or her monthly and annual decisions, a Legacy Giver makes a lifetime or longer-term giving commitment that governs his or her larger decisions like homes, cars, investments, and the like.

WHAT'S THE MORE GOD HAS FOR ME?

OUR **PRIMARY** GOAL

We want 100% of the people in our church to experience a life-changing, faith-building encounter with God by engaging in this initiative. We want everyone to ask the question, "What's the **MORE** God has for me?" This question is going to open the door for God to move in ways beyond anything we can ask or imagine.

OUR **SECONDARY** GOAL

We want to trust God for \$850,000 in generosity over two years in order for Movement to accomplish three initiatives that will help even **MORE** people find and follow God.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR **MADE** FOR **MORE** COMMITMENT

At the end of our MADE FOR **MORE** message series, running from October 25 to November 15, we'll have what we're calling "Commitment Sunday." On November 15 you will have the opportunity to make a new commitment to join the journey, increase your commitment from last year, or affirm your commitment from last year.

Until then, pray and seek how God is calling YOU to be a part of this mission.

3 STEPS TO TAKE ACTION

WE TAKE ACTION. This value has been a foundational part of Movement's story. It is also at the heart of our MADE FOR **MORE** initiative. We have an opportunity to experience God's power and provision by being active in His mission. We are asking you to fully engage in MADE FOR **MORE** by taking three action steps:

1 PRAY INTENTIONALLY

It all starts with prayer. Pray that God works in and through the MADE FOR **MORE** generosity initiative. Pray that His mission would be accomplished and the world around us would be transformed. Pray for how God is calling you to be a part of this mission, realizing that through God's power you are MADE FOR **MORE**.

2 LEAD THE WAY

Be engaged as an ambassador for the MADE FOR **MORE** vision and God's plan to transform lives, neighborhoods, our city, and our world. Spread the word through your support and involvement in what our church is doing.

3 GIVE GENEROUSLY

What resources has God entrusted to you? What would it look like to give in a way that changed you...in a way that made you trust God **MORE**? Prayerfully consider what God is calling you to financially invest over the next year in order to see God move **MORE**.



The **MADE FOR MORE** initiative is an opportunity for **everyone** to take a **step of faith** in their **generosity**. All of us **together** are going to help even **MORE** people **find** and **follow** God.
