1. Has there ever been a time where you felt God was asking you to do something that was bigger than you thought you could handle? Describe that experience.
2. Read Mark 6:30-44. How do you sense the disciples are doing based on these verses? How did Jesus view the crowd differently than the disciples?
3. Can you relate to the example of the disciples in these verses? If so how? Consider, has there been a time in your own life you were less patient and compassionate toward others because of stress or weariness?
4. Why do you think Jesus assigned the disciples to feed the multitude? (6:37) Why did Jesus have the disciples collect the leftovers? (6:43-44, see 8:19-20)
5. This week we encouraged you to pray, "God help me to see the world through your eyes." What do you think God wants to show you through this prayer?
6. How do you think God wants you to be involved in meeting the needs of people in this season? What steps can you take this week?
