

The Angels of Elohim (God) Begin With The Word

To understand the angels of Elohim (God) we need to view this mystery of heaven from the foundational place of the Word of Elohim (God). But not the angels only. All the heavenly hosts and the true servants of Elohim (God) upon the earth must operate from this revelation of the Word.

All things begin with the Word of God.

John 1:1-3,10,11, & 14 (NASB)

*“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim (God),
and the Word was Elohim (God).*

He was in the beginning with Elohim (God).

*All things came into being through Him,
and apart from Him, nothing came into being
that has come into being.*

*He was in the world; the world was made through Him,
and the world did not know Him.*

*He came to His own, and those who
were His own did not receive Him.*

*And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us,
and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father,
full of grace and truth.”*

This holy scripture does not just place Jesus Christ in the beginning of creation. It also makes Jesus Christ the Word of Creation and the ONE Who's voice created all that exists.

This means that ONE existed. Alone. Who was that ONE? Yehoshua the Mashiach (Christ, or, manifested anointing).

Because, it is written, "God is love," (1 John 4:8 & 16) we also know that "the Son of His Love" existed and the first of all creation came at the sound of the voice of Love. Love voiced in Word.

The ONE is Love. Love has the sound of His voice. The Word brought about all that exists. Everything that the ONE says, from the beginning to the end, is Truth. Facts are not Truth.

Anyone who writes His Word must hold fast to the Word of Truth or it is not Truth. When the Word (logos) is written, it has the same authority as His Voice because it is like a permanent recording of His Voiced Word. The gospel written is His Voiced Word of Truth.

Psalms 33:4-9 (NASB)

*“For the word of Yahovah (YHWH) is upright,
and all His work is done in faithfulness.*

He loves righteousness and justice;

The earth is full of the lovingkindness of Yahovah (YHWH).

*6 By the word of Yahovah (YHWH) the heavens were made,
and by the breath of His mouth all their host.*

He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap;

He lays up the deeps in storehouses.

Let all the earth fear Yahovah (YHWH);

Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.

For He spoke, and it was done;

He commanded, and it stood fast.

Psalms 33:4-9 (Tanakh)

For the word of Yahovah (YHWH) is right;

His every deed is faithful.

He loves what is right and just;

the earth is full of Yahovah (YHWH)'s faithful care.

*By the word of Yahovah (YHWH) the heavens were made,
by the breath of His mouth, all their host.*

He heaps up the ocean waters

like a mound, stores the deep in vaults.

Let all the earth fear Yahovah (YHWH);

let all the inhabitants of the world dread Him.

For He spoke, and it was; He commanded, and it endured.

Now let's look at the Word in relation to angels and the hosts of heaven and His servants in every realm.

Psalms 103:19-22

“Yahovah (YHWH) has established His throne in the heavens, and His sovereignty rules over all.

*Bless Yahovah (YHWH), you His angels,
mighty in strength, who perform His word,
Obeying the voice of His word!*

*Bless Yahovah (YHWH), all you His hosts,
you who serve Him, doing His will.*

*Bless Yahovah (YHWH), all you works of His,
in all places of His dominion;*

Bless Yahovah (YHWH), O my soul!

David clearly describes the works of the realms of the heavens in this revelatory Psalm.

- Angels are mighty in strength and perform His word!
- The Hosts of heaven serve Him and do His will!
- The Ministers in all places – in the heavens and the earth – where His Kingdom rules and reigns!

This Davidic revelation teaches us that angels perform God's word or make His works happen.

Our Elohim (God), Yahovah (YHVH) is the Father of lights and the Son of Elohim (God). There is ONE and only ONE. He is Love and His great Love is expressed in a myriad of ways, both in the heavens and on the earth (eretz).

He is epic justice, and His Word is the person of the Son of His Love¹ – His inheritance. He has set His righteous boundaries into creation so that His Word never changes² and it is undeniably just.

Many have thought that the cherubim are only placed as a guard against any beings of the heavens or earth to cross into His domain. But that could never happen without His permission.

Yet, the fortress of Elohim's power has set these mighty cherubim to guard His Word so that even He will not sovereignly act beyond His own Presence.

For instance, in the beginnings of creation, Elohim gave the authority to rule the whole earth unto the human whom He loves. This was an act of His covenant-connection with the human in order that the Creator might be ONE with the human of His love and joy.

However, we must also understand that this edict was never repealed. His Word remains in place, and He will never force Himself into the place that He gave authority to humankind. Thus, His Word remains just and pure. His Word is justice, undeniable, and the unmistakable Truth.

Genesis 1:26-28 (Hebrew Tanakh)

“Elohim (God) said, ‘Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. They shall rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, the cattle, the whole earth, and all the creeping things that creep on earth.’ And Elohim (God) created man (human) in His image, in the image of Elohim (God) He created him; male and female He created them.

Elohim (God) blessed them and Elohim (God) said to them, ‘Be fertile and increase, fill the earth and master (subdue) it, and rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, and all the living things that creep on earth.’”

His first covenants interacted with humans and always required human involvement for Elohim (God) to act sovereignly upon the earth. This is so that He would never break the justice of His Own Word and therefore His Word would never be in question.

Before Yahovah (YHVH) destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, He interacted with Abraham and established His permissions for justice.³

The children of Israel were found to be stiff-necked and Yahovah (YHVH) wanted to destroy them but Moses spoke of His justice and His word.

Deuteronomy 9:13-14 (Hebrew Tanakh)

“Yahovah (YHVH) further said to me, ‘I see that this is a stiff-necked people. Let Me alone, and I will destroy them and blot out their name from under heaven, and I will make you a nation far more numerous than they.’”

³ Genesis 18:32 (Tanakh) "He (Abraham) said, 'Let not my Lord be angry if I speak but this last time: What if ten should be found there?' And He answered, "I will not destroy for the sake of the ten."

This principle of the Holy One's just permissions is revealed in the life of Miriam, the mother of Jesus.

The Holy Angel Gabriel (one of the seven spirits of God)⁴ appeared to Miriam and told her she was God's choice to carry the Son of God in her womb. The angel gave Miriam a glimpse into the future and assured her of how blessed she was to be the chosen.

The permission of justice came when Miriam agreed to all of God's plans for the world and her womb as the Word's gateway to earth.

Luke 1:38

*“Miriam said, ‘Behold. The maidservant of the Lord!
Let it be to me according to your Word.’
And the angel departed from her.”*
