Quodesh Isaiah 6

Isaiah 6:1-7

*In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne,
lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.*

*Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he
covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he
flew. One called out to another and said,*

*“Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts,
The whole earth is full of His glory.”*

*And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him
who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke.*

Then I said,

*“Woe is me, for I am ruined!
Because I am a man of unclean lips,
And I live among a people of unclean lips.
For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.”*

*Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his
hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. He touched my
mouth with it and said, “Behold, this has touched your lips, and
your iniquity is taken away, and your sin is forgiven.”*

Greek hágios family of word meanings

*“Father of us,
Who is in the heavens,
Your name is set/established here as holy.*

Come! Kingdom of You.

Let be done! The will of You.

As in heaven - also on the earth!

The bread of us daily give unto us today. (remember the manna)

Forgive us our debts, as we also forgive the debtors of ours.

And lead us not into temptation,

but deliver us from the evil.

Because of You is the kingdom and the power

and the glory to all the ages (ions).

Amen.”
