Matthew 5:5 (ESV) 5 "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

THE SPIRIT OF MAMMON - This is an actual demon god, not just an atmosphere Mammon was a god that was worshipped in Canaan during the times that Jesus walked the earth.

Symptoms of a spirit of mammon:

- Measuring people by their money or lack thereof
- People no matter how hard they work, still remain impoverished
- Causes wrong thinking regarding money and the use of it without the person knowing.

Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the land.

Moses, Abraham, Jesus are all examples of meekness.

Meek:

Having deep deep resource, but only using the amount needed, being frugal. Yielded, (savings)

Opposite of meek: Unyielded

Having limited resource, yet exampling extravagant, wasteful, prodigal behavior regarding money.

MOTIVATION

The mentality of using God and using His principles to obtain money is off. Relationship with Him is what opens up prosperity and the flow, so the "need for money" is not a healthy reason or driving force, "I will do whatever I need to do to get money"... and or "come and worship (idol of mammon) because we are destitute and need financial rescue.

Spirit of Mammon causes people to become desperate and they begin to use God to obtain money instead of using money to serve God.

What we do is not what is important, the motivation of why we do what we do is what is important. I we using the things of God to build our own kingdoms or our own lives?

Consider the Sparrow

- They are not worried
- They are in peace
- I am going to be ok, because my Father love me

Deuteronomy 8:16-20 (NASB)

16 In the wilderness He fed you manna which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do good for you in the end. 17 Otherwise, you may say in your heart, 'My power and the strength of my hand made me this wealth.' 18 But you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who is giving you

power to make wealth, that He may confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. 19 It shall come about if you ever forget the LORD your God and go after other gods and serve them and worship them, I testify against you today that you will surely perish. 20 Like the nations that the LORD makes to perish before you, so you shall perish; because you would not listen to the voice of the LORD your God.
