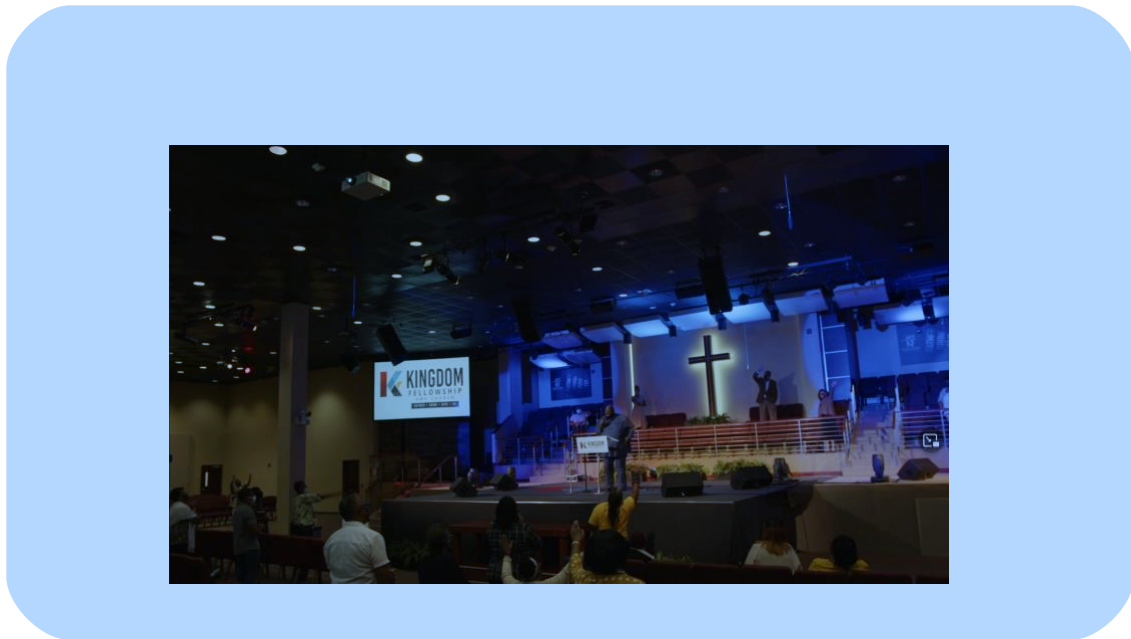




Suggested Chapters to Study This Week: Joshua 3 and Exodus 3

We close with Pastor Denny Davis, the Senior Pastor St. John Church Unleashed in TX, for this final week of our August Preaching Series. The title for the sermon today is “At The Brink,” using Joshua chapter 3. Pastor Davis explains that the word brink represents at the edge or close to the next point in life. Pastor Davis says that “we live in a world that can stretch us to our limits, and if we aren’t careful, it can push us over the edge.” Simone Biles is an example that Pastor Davis gives of someone close to the brink but can come back. We can all move beyond the brink, and we can move beyond the edge. Pastor Davis gives us some points to help us move forward from the scripture in Joshua.



Moving Beyond The Brink:

1. We Must Remember Our previous Lessons
2. We Must Remember Our Previous Leadership.
3. We Must Follow Instructions.
4. We Must Believe That With God Moving Beyond The Brink Is Possible.

Joshua had to lead the people from where they were to where God had promised them and their parents. As Pastor Davis shared, their parents didn't make it, but they did because they followed God beyond the brink. Pastor Davis encourages us to trust as Joshua did in God and the Hope of tomorrow.
