Church Membership

When you open the New Testament, one of the things that becomes very clear on its pages is that the Christian life isn't meant to be lived alone. The New Testament has no conception of someone being a follower of Jesus but disconnected from Jesus' community, the church.

In our age of hyper-individualism, commitment to a local body of believers in covenant community is a counter-cultural statement against self-autonomy. Membership in a local church is a declaration that we are not our own. We belong not only to God, but also to one another.

This is why at Summit we see formal membership in a local church as an essential aspect of discipleship. The Scriptures call us to place ourselves under the accountability of a healthy, humble, gospel-centered group of believers, under the care of godly leaders. Membership in a church is an essential contributor to our own spiritual health. But as members of the church we also are essential contributors to the spiritual health of one another. We need each other!

This morning, as we formally welcome a number of people into membership at Summit, we're anticipating the ways God will grow these members, and grow the rest of us, through their addition to our church family.
