HEIDELBERG CATECHISM

The Heidelberg Catechism is a 16th century, question and answer, discipleship tool. The catechism has a helpful series of questions on the Lord's Prayer that we will include here during our prayer series.

QUESTION 124:

What does it mean to pray "your kingdom come?"

That is, so rule us by your Word and Spirit that more and more we submit to you. Preserve and increase your church. Destroy the works of the devil, every power that raises itself against you, and every conspiracy against your holy Word. Do all this until the fullness of your kingdom comes, wherein you shall be all in all.

QUESTION 123:

What does it mean to pray "your will be done on earth as it is in heaven?"

That is, grant that we and all men may deny our own will, and without any murmuring obey your will, for it alone is good. Grant also that everyone may carry out the duties of his office and calling as willingly and faithfully as the angels in heaven.
