January Sermon Series: Prayer

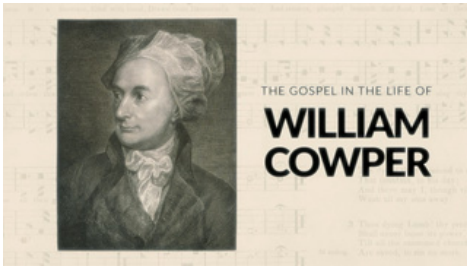
