## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### ***Summer Hangouts***

Summer is the most beautiful time in the Pacific Northwest! Washingtonians love getting outside for hikes, BBQs, park dates, and lake days. That cultural rhythm creates a natural opportunity for deeper connection as a church.

We do Summer Hangouts for two reasons. The first is *fellowship*. As community groups and church programming slow down for the summer, hangouts offer a way to meet new people, stay connected, and build friendships in the rhythms we're already living. Some of the deepest relationships in our church have grown around the grill or on a trail, not just in a study.

The second is *mission*. Casual, open-invite gatherings are one of the simplest ways to bring a neighbor who doesn't know Jesus into the everyday life of our church. There's no pressure and no program, just a shared meal, a walk, or an afternoon at the park. These informal connections expose people to the beauty of gospel community long before they walk through the doors of the church.

Hangouts are simple by design. Anyone can host something they already enjoy, and anyone can show up. They run from June 1st through Labor Day weekend.
