Crossway Network

Our heartbeat at Summit is to know and make known the real Jesus in our church, our city, and across the globe. We pursue that mission as part of the Crossway Network.

Crossway is a network of churches (17 in the U.S. and 5 globally) that unites around shared theological convictions, ministry philosophy, and leadership culture to plant and support healthy, reproducing churches. Crossway churches partner by sharing resources, training church planting leaders and teams, providing ongoing support for pastors, and funding new church plants.

We belong to a region within Crossway called the "Mountain Pacific Region" made up of Summit, Creekside Community Church (McMinnville, OR), Kaleo Church (Aberdeen, WA), Sheridan Bible Church (Sheridan, WY), and Mountain View Bozeman (Bozeman, MT). We are excited about the collaboration and partnership to see our churches be healthy and, Lord willing, plant 2-3 new church plants in the next few years.
