WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Baptism

Baptism is one of the two main sacraments in the life of the church (the other is the Lord's Supper). Baptism is both a *sign* that portrays what has happened to a person when they put their faith in Jesus, and a *seal*, or 'means of grace' that the Spirit uses to root a believer in the promises of the gospel.

Baptism beautifully shows us two things:

First, the use of water is a visible symbol that God has forgiven us and cleansed us from our sins by the blood of Christ. Second, baptism is a portrait of our union with Christ. When we trust in Jesus, the Scriptures say that we are crucified with him (Gal. 2:20), buried into his death (Col. 2:12), and raised with him to new life (Rom. 6:4). His life, death, and resurrection become ours. Baptism demonstrates to everyone watching the wonder of what God has done.

Through baptism, the entire church is invited to celebrate the gospel and remember God's work in their own lives. Baptism happens to an individual but it's inseparably tied to the church community. This is why we recite the truth of 2 Corinthians 5:17 together as the person baptized comes out of the water: "If anyone is in Christ, the old has gone, the new has come."
