At Summit we believe that the dedication of a child is a meaningful, formal, public commitment that is a delight to the heart of God. In this public dedication there are three "actors".

First, are the parents who publicly commit to raising their child (by God's grace and in his power) to love and follow Jesus, creating a loving, grace-filled home environment that cultivates the safety and openness of the gospel.

Second, is the Church which publicly commits to encouraging, supporting, exhorting, and loving both the child being dedicated and their parents as part of our covenant community at Summit. This is why we require people to be members at Summit in order to dedicate their children.

Thirdly, we believe God also "acts", in that as we celebrate his providence in placing this child in a Christian home, in the context of the covenant community of the church, he uses this public commitment as a means of grace in the life of each family.
