## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### **Giving**

You are not your own. Through the gospel, we have been bought with a price. That means that all we are and all we have belongs to Jesus. Including our finances.

Our tendency is to consider first how our money serves our kingdom. But the Scriptures encourage us to think primarily about how it serves God's. Since local churches are meant to be embassies of God's kingdom in this world, giving in the context of the local church should be a priority for the Christian. This kind of generosity not only reflects the values of God's kingdom, it also frees our hearts from the grip our treasure can hold over us.

Ultimately, our giving is always a responsive act. We give because God gave. God has been unspeakably generous toward us. He has lavishly given us life and love, breath and beauty. But the supreme example of his generosity is in the giving of his own Son. The gospel makes us generous people. People who joyfully give of all they have for the glory of God and the good of others.
