Responsive Reading

During our times of gathered worship on a Sunday, you might be asked to participate in a corporate responsive reading. But what is a responsive reading?

The tradition of responsive readings dates back to the early church, was continued by the Puritans and reformers, and remains a regular element in the liturgy of many churches today. Responsive readings are just that, a reading that is done responsively, out loud, often with a leader and the congregation trading sections of a given text ("call and response"). These readings might consist of a portion of Scripture, a prayer, or a written meditation that highlights themes found in God's word. As we read these truths we not only learn and process ourselves but we also build one another as well.

We include responsive readings in our liturgy because we love how they help us link arms with saints who have gone before us, they encourage us to participate during corporate worship, they help us teach and learn the truths of God's Word, and they unite us as we worship our great God.
