WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Community Groups

From the very beginning, God designed his people to live in deep relationships with one another. In Genesis 2, when God says to Adam, "It is not good for man to be alone," he is speaking not primarily about marriage but about the essential need for community.

This theme continues in the New Testament. Jesus didn't come only to save individuals but to bring us into a new community - the church - where he reigns as King. Here, the goodness, grace, and love God shows us are meant to overflow in our relationships with one another. Simply put: the gospel creates community.

At Summit, Community Groups are our primary way of living out this biblical call to community. These groups are more than just mid-week Bible studies—they're a family where we gather with brothers and sisters to share meals, pray, encourage one another, bear each other's burdens, and remind each other of the gospel. Often, it's in these ordinary, everyday spaces that the beauty of the gospel shines most clearly.

Each Community Group has its own rhythm. Some meet weekly, others bi-weekly. Some share a meal every time, others less often. But in every group, no matter the neighborhood or the leaders, we come together to know and make known the real Jesus.
