St. John's Endowment Fund

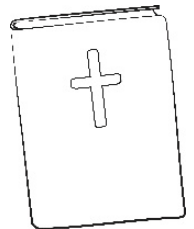
There are always things we would like to do at St. John's that don't fit into the budget. In the last couple of years, we have started an Endowment Fund. Five percent of the Endowment Fund is distributed each year. Any group, committee, or member of the congregation can apply for the available funds to address a non-budgeted need or project at St. John's. The past few years have seen the distributions used for an exterior sign at school, tuition aid for a member attending the Seminary, and money allocated to a new preschool playground. Applications are available at each campus and are due by August 31. A completed application can be submitted to any Pastor, the Church Office, or any member of the Church Council.

Bible Information Classes Start September 12!

Pastor Papenfuss will be leading a Bible Information Class (BIC) throughout this fall! The class will meet on Saturday mornings in Juneau from 10:00-11:30 AM, starting on September 12th.
