St. John's Endowment Fund

There are always things we would like to do at St. John's that don't fit into the budget. In the last couple of years, we have started an Endowment Fund. Five percent of the Endowment Fund is distributed each year. Any group, committee, or member of the congregation can apply for the available funds to address a non-budgeted need or project at St. John's. The past three years have seen the distributions used for an exterior sign at school, tuition aid for a member attending the Seminary, and money allocated to a new preschool playground.

This year, there is about \$3,600 available for disbursement. Applications are available at each campus and are due by August 30. A completed application can be submitted to any Pastor, the Church Office, or any member of the Church Council.
