Storm Damage Fundraising Updates:

Due to damages caused during the tornado outbreak in Spring of 2025, our church properties have many needed repairs including roof replacement. The deductible dollar amount that St. John's is responsible for is \$187,794.36. This deductible is spread out across the two churches, the school, and 4 parsonages.

St. John's is starting a fundraising drive to help cover this cost. A chart will be displayed in the Juneau narthex showing fundraising progress.
