Storm Damage Update:

The Trustee's have received the insurance estimates from Church Mutual regarding the storm damage from last year. The deductible dollar amount for the repairs that St. John's is responsible for is \$187,794.36. This deductible is spread out across the two churches, the school, and 4 parsonages. We will be starting a fundraising drive in January. A chart will be displayed in the Narthex showing the progress of the fund raising. Any and all donations will be greatly appreciated. The repairs will be starting in June of 2026.
