Pastor Mount has previously announced his decision to step away from our church. His last sermon will be June 14th. We wish God's blessings to him and his family!

St. John's church leadership has been working with our WELS District President, Pastor Jensen, who has been offering guidance to help our church through this time of transition. Several key changes are in the works, including finding pastors to assist us during this vacancy. More details will be announced over the next couple of weeks.

Among the initial changes, our voters have issued a new call to our previous Staff Minister, Ryan Kummerow. With this call, Ryan would primarily be working within our shut-in member ministry. Please pray for him as he deliberates this new call to serve within our congregation.

The voters have also approved applying for a graduate student from the seminary. Please pray for all the students, including our senior assistant Nathan Boulden, as they receive calls into the full-time ministry.
