



1 John 5:5-12 EHV

The Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. ⁷ In fact, there are three that testify: ⁸ the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and these three are one.

⁹ If we accept the testimony of people, God's testimony is even greater, because it is the testimony that God gave about his Son. ¹⁰ The one who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in him, but the one who does not believe has made God out to be a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God gave about his Son. ¹¹ This is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹² The one who has the Son has life. NICENE CREED

The peace of the Lord be with you always.




