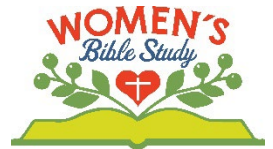
Let's Get Moving Together!

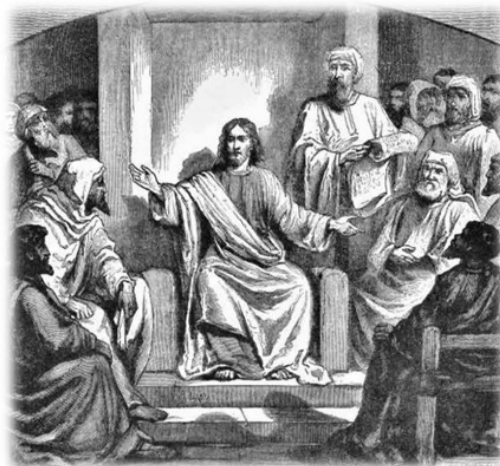
Share the Love! Help The Pregnancy Support Center's mission by filling a bag!
