
WHAT HE WILL DO:

WORSHIP : He is turning us into true worshippers. Jesus sings 2 times in the new testament. He mentions the word worship 3 times, addressing 3 people (the scribes, the samaritan and satan).

Touching on 3 main aspects of worship (the venue, the value, and the veracity of worship). It would be wise for us to know what Jesus says about worship. Jesus mentions that He is looking for true worshippers. The assumption is that there are also false worshippers. Let's learn to become true worshippers, with our spirits awake and witnessing, knowing well the One we worship, representing Him rightly.

THE CHURCH : The Scriptures have many different analogies used for the church.

It's good to know that Jesus will build it and it belongs to Him. He has not handed over ownership to anyone else, and hasn't asked us to build it either. In ecclesiology we will also look at the biblical insight on how to govern churches and what are the important essentials that make a church a church. Church history will help us to see the fruit of ignorance and arrogance so that we can make a more faithful future.

HEAVEN : Do we live with eternity in our hearts? Do we live with eternity in our minds? There is such hope for what is still to come. The invisible world is more real than that which is visible. How real is it for us who are still alive. How do we consider life beyond that which we can see? The father of our faith, Abraham, lived simply, having his eyes set on another kingdom, whose designer and builder is God. Let us live looking up! Learning to live beyond that which is temporary, knowing what is of eternal value.

HIS RETURN : Two main things we should know about the end times. No1: He is certainly going to return. No2: It would be very good for us if we were ready when He does return. A healthy view of eschatology will help us finish the race well, living out God's calling and purposes with peace and joy. We will also make His Name great in our generation, enjoying living here as aliens, strangers and ambassadors. Eschatology should remain a minor doctrine as there are various interpretations about how things will end. If we turn eschatology into a major doctrine and become too precious about our views, we can destroy many relationships with brothers and sisters because we over valued something that never should have been.

FINAL JUDGEMENT : When considering the final judgement, it would be good to let the character and nature of God govern and saturate our minds and hearts while studying this doctrine. He is Perfect,

He is Just, He is Righteous etc. We get to trust and rest in the factual Truth that when God makes His judgements, it will be a righteous, just and perfect judgement. This means that one day when we look with fully opened eyes, no longer through a dim glass, we will not disagree or see any unrighteousness or imperfections in His judgements and also with all that He finally decides.
