THE ARMOR OF GOD

EPHESIANS 6:10-18 – THE FULL
PASSAGE, TO READ AND REFERENCE

Here's the full passage this volume is built on – straight from Scripture. **Read it slowly, out loud if you can.** Let it land before you move on.

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord,
and in the strength of his might.

11 Put on the whole armor of God,
that you may be able to stand
against the wiles of the devil.

12 For our wrestling is not against
flesh and blood, but against the
principalities, against the
powers, against the world's
rulers of the darkness of this
age, and against the spiritual
forces of wickedness in the
heavenly places.

13 Therefore put on the whole
armor of God, that you may be
able to withstand in the evil day,
and, having done all, to stand.

14 Stand therefore, having the
utility belt of truth buckled
around your waist, and having
put on the breastplate of
righteousness,

15 and having fitted your feet with
the preparation of the Good
News of peace,

16 above all, taking up the shield of
faith, with which you will be able
to quench all the fiery darts of
the evil one.

17 And take the helmet of
salvation, and the sword of the
Spirit, which is the word of God;

18 with all prayer and requests,
praying at all times in the Spirit,
and being watchful to this end
in all perseverance and
requests for all the saints.
