
WHO HE IS :

TRINITY : From the very beginning of the Bible, the words in the book of Genesis... “let US make man in OUR image”... helps us to see that there is more than One, Who is revealed as the Maker and Creator God. How many is not clarified here. But as the Scriptures unfold, we find that there are Three that are revealed. The Three are revealed as One God. God the Father. God the Son. God the Holy Spirit

CHARACTER : Those who know Your Name(character and reputation), put their trust in You (Psalm 9:10). From the words of the psalmist, no one rightly worships, serves and trusts a God that they do not know. And why would anyone want to trust a God who is unknown, never-mind serve or even worship them. It is the nurturing of a

high view of God that will develop a worship that is true. Revelations of the character, nature and attributes of God stirs and grows our trust and our faith in Him. An unknown God can neither be trusted, served or worshiped, but revelations of the Divine character, inspires awe, and provokes worship. The basis of our troubles, is that our God is too small. We can't make Him big, we need to see Him big. If we get to know Him rightly, we can also display Him rightly.

WORD : Every tribe, tongue and nation is able to see something of the nature and character of a Creator. Unless humanity's rebellious nature resists this revelation, all hearts are stirred towards a detailed Designer, as they gaze and ponder on all that has been created. But these revelations are just the beginning.

We will also begin to see His nature and character revealed even more clearly, as we do some heart pondering and meditations into the Book called the Bible. The Bible speaks of the Creator's nature and character with more clarity, revealing His story and invitation to humanity in more detail, to the hearts of the hungry. The Bible begins to grow in authority over our lives, transforming our traditions, cultures, views, thinking, opinions, affections and appetites. We find the Scriptures necessary and essential for ongoing relational enlightenment. We also find it sufficient for finding our purpose in living this life to the fullest, with peace in our hearts.
