How Jesus Would Raise Your Child

When the enemy came to tempt Jesus in the wilderness, He did not argue, panic, or strive. Three times He simply answered, "**It is written**"—and stood on the Word of God. That same Word is ours to stand on, and to speak, over the children He has entrusted to us.

This is not a lesson about being a perfect parent. It is an invitation to raise our children the way the perfect One would—and to declare over them what Heaven already says is true. What follows is fourteen things Jesus would do and speak over your child, drawn from His own words and His own example.

How to use this: read each one slowly. Pray it. Speak it aloud—at bedtime, in the car, over a sleeping child, in the middle of a hard day. You are not conjuring something new; you are simply agreeing with what God has already written.

His Heart Toward Them

1 He Would Welcome Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"Allow the little children to come to me! Don't forbid them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these."

Mark 10:14 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are wanted. There is room for you in His arms and a place for you in His Kingdom. Nothing—not even your own smallness—can keep you from coming to Jesus.

2 He Would Bless Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"He took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands on them."

Mark 10:16 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: the hands of God rest on you for good. You are blessed, set apart, and held. What He has spoken over you, no one can unspeak.

3 He Would Treasure Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"Whoever receives one such little child in my name receives me."

Matthew 18:5 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are no inconvenience and no afterthought. To welcome you is to welcome Christ Himself. Heaven counts you precious.

4

He Would Defend Their Worth

IT IS WRITTEN

"See that you don't despise one of these little ones, for I tell you that in heaven their angels always see the face of my Father who is in heaven."

Matthew 18:10 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are never overlooked. You are seen, named, and valued in heaven. Your worth is settled by God—not by anyone's opinion of you.

5

He Would Be Gentle With Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"He won't break a bruised reed. He won't quench a smoking flax, until he leads justice to victory."

Matthew 12:20 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: when you are bruised, you will not be broken. When your flame burns low, it will not be snuffed out. The Lord is tender with the fragile—and He is tender with you.

6

He Would Pursue Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish."

Matthew 18:14 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: even if you wander, you will not be lost for good. Heaven will come looking for you, because it is never your Father's will that you should be lost.

He Would Never Leave Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Matthew 28:20 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are never alone. Wherever you go, however far, His presence goes with you—to the very end of the age.

His Words Over Them

He Would Call Them Beloved

IT IS WRITTEN

"You are my beloved Son. In you I am well pleased."

Luke 3:22 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: before you achieve a single thing, you are loved. As the Father delighted in His Son, His delight rests on you. You are beloved, and in you He is well pleased.

9

He Would Call Them Friend

IT IS WRITTEN

"No longer do I call you servants... but I have called you friends."

John 15:15 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are not merely a servant or a student of God—you are His friend. He longs to walk with you, speak with you, and share His heart with you.

10 He Would Call Them Light

IT IS WRITTEN

"You are the light of the world. A city located on a hill can't be hidden."

Matthew 5:14 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are not darkness searching for light—you are light. You were made to shine, to be seen, to carry warmth and truth wherever you go.

11 He Would Speak Truth Over Them

IT IS WRITTEN

"Sanctify them in your truth. Your word is truth."

John 17:17 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: His Word is true, and His truth will set you free and keep you. You will be shaped not by the lies of this world, but by the truth of God.

12 He Would Teach Them to Love

IT IS WRITTEN

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, that you also love one another."

John 13:34 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are learning to love because you are first deeply loved. As Christ has loved you, so you will love—and the world will know whose you are.

13 He Would Give Them His Peace

IT IS WRITTEN

"Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you... Don't let your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful."

John 14:27 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: peace is your inheritance. Not the fragile peace the world hands out, but His peace. Your heart need not be troubled, and you need not be afraid.

14 He Would Build Them to Stand

IT IS WRITTEN

"Everyone therefore who hears these words of mine and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on a rock."

Matthew 7:24 (WEB)

I declare over you, my child: you are being built on the Rock. When the rains fall and the winds beat against your life, you will not collapse. You will stand—because your foundation is Christ.

A BENEDICTION

What Is Written Stands

These are His words, not ours—already true, already spoken in heaven over your child long before we ever declared them on earth. We do not have to manufacture their worth, their calling, or their security. We simply agree with the One who has already settled it all.

So when fear says otherwise, when the day goes wrong, when you wonder whether any of it is sinking in—come back here, and declare again what is written.

He is gentle. He is faithful. And He loves your child even more than you do.
