WHAT REALLY MATTERS

- we race thru life, and everybody is busy, busy, busy
- rarely do we stop and think about the things that are really important
 - in fact, we live in a time when the world has lost the concept of what is really important
- as we approach different seasons in our lives, we often ask where did all the time go
- we should be asking some serious questions like
 - what does success look like
 - what is a life well-lived
 - where am I headed
 - what are the really important things of life
- we are in a section of Luke where we are looking at 8 principles of things that are worthy of serious consideration

1. (18-20) A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST

- Jesus is in the area of Caesera Philippi
 - show video =

- there are many opinions about Christ
- the only opinion that matters is yours it has eternal implica-

2. (<u>21-22</u>, <u>43-45</u>) THE DEATH AND RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

- this revelation came after the disciples had confessed that Jesus was the Christ

3. (23-26) GETTING THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE

- it all begins with desire here
- do you really want to be a follower of Jesus

- deny yourself
- take up your cross daily
- follow Jesus
- the more you let go of yourself, the happier you will be

4. (27-36) THERE IS A FUTURE GLORY

- notice that Jesus went to the mountain to pray
 - Luke often emphasizes the prayer life of Jesus
- Jesus was transfigured
 - perhaps this is the same "clothing" that Adam and Eve had in the Garden
- the fact that Moses and Elijah are there with Jesus shows that God is the God of the living
 - what will be the outcome of your appearance before God after you die?
- notice the exhortation to "hear Jesus"

5. (37-42) KEEP THE MAIN THING THE MAIN THING

- as soon as they came down from the mountain-top experience with Jesus, they were confronted with the cruel realities of life
 - it is so easy to get distracted, isn't it?
 - we all have an enemy of our soul who would like nothing more than to get us away from Jesus
- -why couldn't the disciples cast out the demon when Jesus had given them the power and authority back in $v.\underline{1}$
- another gospel says this does not happen apart from prayer and fasting
- the point here = you can't live off of the high of yesterday's victories you must keep your relationship with Christ fresh and new every day (see v.41)

6. (46-48) THE PATH TO GREATNESS

- this discussion comes after the failure of the disciples to cast out the demon
- what is it that compels us to compare ourselves with everybody else to see how we measure up
- notice that Jesus was aware of what they thinking about
- Jesus uses a child to illustrate what He is about to teach these guys
 - You can tell a lot about a person by how they treat the children in the room. Some people feel that children are nothing but trouble.
- where does greatness come from, and what is the path to greatness
 - greatness comes from humility and being a servant
 - Jesus used words like <u>last</u>, <u>least</u>, <u>lowest</u>, <u>servant</u>, <u>slave</u>
- when it comes to serving people, folks usually fall into one of four areas
 - 1. I am not doing anything somebody else can do it
 - 2. What's in it for me if I give up my time and energy to serve somebody else
 - 3. I might help if I am asked to
 - 4. I will look for any opportunity to serve without being asked
- speak about attitude while serving

7. (49-56) DON'T BE SO QUICK TO JUDGE

- John answered . . . what was the question $% \left\{ 1,2,...,N\right\}$
 - It's like John just changes the subject as Jesus was talking about greatness and being the least
- two stories that make the same point

- sometimes we get jealous when people do things differently than we do
- we can get so nitpicky about the differences between us that unbelievers don't have a clue as to who this Jesus is we claim to follow.
 - Remember, Jesus said in <u>John 13:35</u> By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
- sometimes we get mad when sinners act like sinners

8. (57-62) BE ALL IN

- emotion of the moment =
 - Jesus responds simply = follow me
- I will be totally committed to You after . . .
 - Jesus responds Get busy now
- You will never mover forward if you are constantly looking back

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
