LEARNING TO TRUST

- the world is filled with uncertainty, and we have become skeptical about everything
- we have lost trust in people, politics, and even church
- we don't know who to believe, and nobody seems to be concerned about what is true or false
- there is One who is worthy of our trust

1. WHAT DETERMINES RELATIONSHIP

(16-18) ANOTHER PARABLE

- there is a great responsibility if we are exposed to the word of God, and every person ought to seriously consider what is being said here
 - We have a responsibility to share whatever truth God has shown us
 - What about our story, our testimony
 - We have a responsibility to take heed how we hear
 - We are accountable for what we hear
- the more we active in responding, the more we will be shown

(19-21) IMPORTANCE OF HEARING AND DOING

- the family members came to Jesus thinking that He was "over the edge
- some thought that family may have had some special privilege
- Jesus identified "family" as anyone who hears the Word of God and does it
 - Sometimes we get the mistaken notion that if we go through all the motions that we are somehow connected to God
 - Relationship = hearing **and** doing

2. AUTHORITY OVER NATURE

(22-23) CAUGHT IN A STORM

- Jesus plainly told His disciples = "Let's cross over to the other side"
- as they were crossing over, Jesus caught up on some muchneeded rest, even as a bad storm developed
 - Jesus slept while the disciples were filled with fear

(24-25) WINDS AND WAVES OBEY JESUS

- when awakened, Jesus wasn't troubled by the storm, but did rebuke the disciples for their lack of faith
 - Remember what Jesus had told them before they started out = "Let's cross over to the other side."
 - What do you think that meant = they were going to make it to the other side
- sometimes when God allows storms in our life it is that we might learn to trust Him
- a few passages to encourage you in the journey between here and there
 - Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.
 - Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
 - <u>Philippians 1:6</u> being confident of this very thing, that
 He who has begun a good work in you will complete it
 until the day of Jesus Christ;
 - <u>Joel 2:25</u> "So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten, The crawling locust, The

- consuming locust, And the chewing locust, My great army which I sent among you.
- <u>Luke 12:32</u> "Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

3. AUTHORITY OVER THE SUPERNATURAL

(26-29) JESUS MEETS A DEMON-POSSESSED MAN

- they reached their destination just as Jesus said they would
- they were met by a man tormented by demons for a long time
 - This man was driven by the demons to the wilderness in order to destroy him
 - Remember that the Devil only comes to steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10)

(30-33) JESUS CASTS THE DEMONS OUT

- when Jesus asked the name of the demon, they responded by saying legion
 - A Roman legion was 6,000 men
- they begged Jesus not to send the abyss
 - This is the abusso the bottomless pit described in <u>Revelation 9:11</u> a place where demons are held in captivity
- the demons requested to enter a herd of pigs, which Jesus permitted, and they immediately ran down a cliff and were drowned in the Sea of Galilee
 - Here you have the beginning of deviled ham

(34-37) THE PEOPLE BEG JESUS TO LEAVE

- once the people herd what had happened and saw the man in his right mind, they were filled with fear
- *** Jesus always brings life, hope, and a new beginning ***
- but, just like it is today, the crowds really didn't want Him around messing up their routines

(38-39) THE DELIVERED MAN WANTS TO FOLLOW JESUS

- unlike the crowds, the man wanted to follow Jesus wherever He went
- Jesus told him what He still says to us today = "Return to your own house, and tell what great things God has done for you."
 - How's that working for you?

4. AUTHORITY OVER SICKNESS AND DEATH

(40-42) A SICK DAUGHTER ABOUT TO DIE

- crowds were waiting for Jesus as He came back across the Sea of Galilee
- He was met by Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, probably in Capernaum
 - David Guzik = The ruler of the synagogue was somewhat like a modern pastor. He managed both the spiritual and the business affairs of the synagogue.
- in his time of desperation he went to the only One who could bring hope
 - Maybe you need to bring your situation to Jesus today
- but as Jesus made His way with Jairus, He was thronged by the crowds

(43-44) A SICK WOMAN TOUCHES JESUS

- as Jesus was surrounded by the crowds, there was one in the crowd who was also desperate
- she had been sick as long as Jairus had his daughter 12 years
- the doctors weren't able to help her, and she has spent all that she had
- her only hope was to touch Jesus

• Is there a longing to come and touch Jesus so you can be made whole?

(45-48) THE WOMAN GOES AWAY HEALED

(49-56) A GIRL RAISED FROM THE DEAD
