Isaiah 48:22 (NKJV) Romans 16:20 (NKJV)

- 1. The world is in confusion and turmoil.
- A. God knows that the first thing He does is to establish peace between us.
- 1 Corinthians 14:33 (NKJV)
- B. While the world is in turmoil, the Kingdom of God is at peace.
- C. The kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost. Romans 14:17 (NKJV)
- D. Definition of peace it implies prosperity, to join, be at one with, quiet, rest, set at one again.
- E. Peace is a blessing from God. Psalm 29:11 (NKJV)
- F. Peace is also a fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23 (NKJV)
- G. Peace is the second attribute of wisdom James 3:17-18 (NKJV)
- H. Fruitfulness is the result of seed sown in peace.
- I. Walking in peace is essential when we're going into battle.
- J. Jesus came first to bring peace between man and God. Romans 5:1 (NKJV)
- K. God rules our hearts and lives not through fear, but by peace. Colossians 3:15 (NKJV)
- L. Peace is such an important need, that's why peace is the platform of evangelism. Romans 10:13-15 (NKJV)
- M. When we're wounded by the fallen world we live in, it makes us fearful of our vulnerabilities. Isaiah 53:5 (NKJV), Acts 10:35-38 (NKJV)
- 2. Once you find peace you have to hold onto it. Exodus 14:9-16 (NKJV)
- A. If you hold your peace, God will fight your battles.

- B. God told Moses to quit crying and speak to Israel to move forward and to use his rod or authority. Israel almost lost this battle by losing their peace.
- C. They were waiting on God, and God was waiting on them.
- D. The Hebrew word here for hold is -
- E. Only when we hold our peace can God fight our battles. Lose the peace lose the battle!
- F. Sometimes, when someone is attacking us verbally, the hardest thing in the world to do is hold your peace.
- G. If people talk bad about you and others and you don't talk bad about them, people can figure it out.
- H. Your tongue can cause you to lose your peace. 1 Peter 3:8-11 (NKJV)
- I. Being spiritually minded will keep you in peace and bring life to you and those around you. Romans 8:6 (NKJV)
- J. The devil's strategy is to steal your peace. John 10:10 (NKJV)
- K. If the enemy can separate you from your peace, he can separate you from your God.
- L. Peace is the result of eliminating those things that separate us from God. Ephesians 2:14 (NKJV)
- M. The blood of Jesus is the vehicle of God's peace.

3. Take the six steps to holding on to the peace of God

- Step 1: You must pursue and seek peace. Psalm 34:14 (NKJV)
 Philippians 4:6-8 (NKJV)
- Step 2: Right thinking is necessary to hold on to your peace.
- Step 3: Choose not to be easily offended. Psalm 119:165 (NKJV)
- Step 4: Build peace by trusting in God's Word. Isaiah 26:3 (NKJV)
- 5. Multiply your peace by getting to know God more through His Word. We must always approach God's promises in peace. 2 Peter 1:2-4 (NKJV)
- **6. We must forgive and release all bitterness.** Peace with God is not possible unless we have made every attempt to be at peace with all men. **Hebrews 12:12-15 (NKJV)**
