Unfiltered: Seeing God Clearly In A World Of Distortion Part 3 ⇒ Seeing Who You Are



We need to clearly see all God has for us to be able to walk in all God has for us. **CLEAR SIGHT leads to a CONFIDENT WALK.** To the degree that I clearly see can I walk in all God has for me! **We gotta see so we can walk!**

Many have a profound *Identity & Purpose from God*, have an unbelievable *Inheritance & Possessions In Him*, and have incredible *Influence & Power* available to them, and yet don't know it, don't access it, and don't walk in it. *And so we settle into a mediocre or defeated life*.

Hosea 4:6

"My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also reject you as my priests; because you have ignored the law of your God, I also will ignore your children."

It's Possible To Have Something and Not See It:

People In Jesus' Hometown ⇒ "Scoffing, Offense & Unbelief" ⇒ Mark 6:1-6: "1 Jesus left that part of the country and returned with his disciples to Nazareth, his hometown. 2 The next Sabbath he began teaching in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. They asked, "Where did he get all this wisdom and the power to perform such miracles?" 3 Then they scoffed, "He's just a carpenter, the son of Mary and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon. And his sisters live right here among us." They were deeply offended and refused to believe in him. 4 Then Jesus told them, "A prophet is honored everywhere except in his own hometown and among his relatives and his own family." 5 And because of their unbelief, he couldn't do any miracles among them except to place his hands on a few sick people and heal them. 6 And he was amazed at their unbelief."

It's Possible To Be A "Believer" And Yet Miss It ⇒ Matthew 13:9-16:

"9 Whoever has ears, let them hear." 10 The disciples came to him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?" 11 He replied, "Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. 12 Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. 13 This is why I speak to them in parables: "Though <u>seeing</u>, they do not <u>see</u>; though <u>hearing</u>, they do not <u>hear</u> or <u>understand</u>. 14 In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. 15 For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might <u>see</u> with their <u>eyes</u>, <u>hear</u> with their <u>ears</u>, <u>understand</u> with their <u>hearts</u> and <u>turn</u>, and I would <u>heal</u> them.' 16 But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear."

Real Talk With Jesus:

- (a) Unclaimed Assets Occur When We Scoff, Take On Offense, Or Walk In Unbelief,
- We Can See But Not Pay Attention,
- We Can Hear But Not Understand,
- (3) We Can Have A Heart But Become Calloused.

This all plays out in **Ephesians 1:15-23:**

"15 For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all God's people, 16 I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers. 17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. 18 I

pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, 19 and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength 20 he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, 21 far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. 22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way."

Paul Prayed For These Believers To See 3 Things...

- 1) Their <u>Calling</u> ⇒ *IDENTITY* & *PURPOSE* ⇒ *To See* <u>Who You Are</u> *In Christ!* If you know who you are, you will never again be someone else!
- 2) **Their** <u>Inheritance</u> ⇒ *INHERITANCE & POSSESSIONS* ⇒ *To See* <u>What You Have</u> *In Christ!* If you know what you have, you will never again settle for what you got!
- 3) **Their Power** ⇒ **INFLUENCE & POWER** ⇒ **To See** <u>What You Can Do</u> **In Christ!** If you know what you can do, you will never again settle for limitations!

Seeing Your Calling: Who You Are In Christ...

If you know who you are, you will never again be someone else!

We are all living today what we believe about ourself. Where the mind goes, the man follows! Your perception of yourself is so important. How you view yourself determines & affects so much in your life. You'll never behave consistently in a way that contradicts your view of yourself.

Who Defines You?

The question of "Who AM I?" & "Who Defines Me?" is one people have wrestled with for centuries. Even Jesus. Jesus was challenged with the question of "Who AM I?" in <u>Luke 4</u>. Right before Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, He had

been affirmed by God in His Identity and **Who HE WAS** at His Baptism: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased"

□ Luke 3:22 □ As soon as that occurred, the Holy Spirit led Him into the desert to be tempted by the devil.


Of the 3 temptations the devil used on Jesus, two of them began with this challenge: "If you are the Son of God..."

Jesus had just been affirmed in His identity at His baptism. Right after, the devil challenged Him in His identity, asking Him, "Who Defines You?" He questioned His identity, egging Him on saying, "If you are the Son of God, turn these stones into bread. If you are the Son of God, jump off the highest part of the Temple..." Jesus had just been affirmed in God about His identity, and now the devil questioned and challenged it.

⇒ ⇒ AND RIGHT AFTER, HIS MINISTRY EXPLODED IN POWER!

When we were born again, we received a new identity that can be summed up in 2 words: "In Christ"! At some point you will be asked the question: "WHO ARE YOU?

<u>How will you answer this question?</u> Who defines you is so important because *perception is reality*. God has already defined you, but if you choose to believe another definition, <u>to you</u> that will be reality. Parents & People can define you, *Pain can, Problems can, or God can define you...*
