Intro: When a desire to build something arises, there should first be a plan. In (Luke 14:28-30) Jesus tells a parable, "For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it-lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.' — It is in the very nature of man to strive to build things...most of which are in vain. This should not be the case when building the Church, because it has to be done God's way!

I. KNOWING THE BUILDER – HIS PLAN! – Before the foundation of the earth, God had a master plan to build His Church. He had patiently waited for centuries to unfold this great mystery. Let's takes a moment to examine what Paul writes in (Eph 3:8-12) – GOD'S PLAN
<b>A. Was Formerly</b> — <b>(Eph 3:8-9)</b> "To me (Paul), who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles <u>the unsearchable riches of Christ</u> , 9 and to make all see what is <u>the fellowship of the mystery</u> , which from the beginning of the ages has been <u>hidden in God</u> who created all things through Jesus Christ;"-
B. Was to Reveal His Infinite – (Eph 3:10) "to the intent that <u>now the manifold</u> wisdom of God might be MADE KNOWN by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places,"
C. Was with – (Eph 3:11-12) "according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, 12 in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him. As believer's, we are part of God's purpose as a Church, to build His Church – (1 Cor 3:9) "For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field; you are God's building."
Closing Point: The Church is <u>not just an earthly organization</u> , but a divine which reveals <b>His purposes for all creation</b> . We must understand that God has an <i>infinite master plan</i> of which He desires to use us as we <u>walk in faith</u> . (Matthew 16:18) "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and <u>on this rock, I will build My church</u> , and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it." (Do you have the faith to participate in this mater plan?)
II. TRUSTING THE BUILDER – As I mentioned in my introduction, mankind loves to do things in the flesh, or 'his own way.' At Calvary Chapel, we realize that we can never build God's Church. And when we do build it in the flesh, we build it wrong, stumbling people in the

process! Our approach then is to **BE AVAILABLE**, but also Trust God to build it His way!
