## FAMILY PLANNING | GENESIS 16-17 | PASTOR MARK BOFILL | 8/06/2023

I. The Fleshly Plan (16:1-6) | II. The Escape Plan (16:7-16) | III. The Master Plan (17:1-27)

INTRO: Last week we learned how *God had promised Abraham a son from his own body* (15:4), and **Abram believed God!** (Amen... I'm going to be a daddy!). What God did NOT reveal was WHEN the child would be born! — He's now 85 years old which means that it was approximately 3-8 years since God last spoke with him about the Hebrew family plan. — These next two ch's expose 3 different approaches to Family Planning, revealing both Human and Divine plans...

- **I. FLESHLY PLANS (16:1-6)** The Bible makes clear that when the people of God fail to **Wait on God** and **Trust in Him** <u>at all times</u>, we soon stumble. **(Prov 14:12)**, *There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.* The <u>spotlight now turns to Sarai</u>...
  - A. Sara' Predicament (1-4a) Her Increase in age plus Waiting on God seemingly taxed her Patience, driving her to her own fleshly resolve. Most people don't like to wait, but it's a key ingredient to building faith. (Heb. 6:12), tells us that it is through "faith and patience [that we] inherit the promises"
    - **1. Sarai's** <u>Desperation</u> (1-2a) Her assessment was <u>based on sight and circumstance</u>, which produced *contempt towards God* for His "<u>lack of involvement</u>." *She was hopelessly infertile*, so she decided to resort to a <u>surrogate marriage plan</u>, which was a perfectly respectable practice in the other cultures of the ancient Near East. A child born to a slave-girl could be regarded as the wife's own child, if she had no children of her own.
    - 2. Sarai's <u>Decision</u> (2b-4a) Was <u>not an act of faith</u> but was a **FLESHLY PLAN!** The word "Perhaps" implies <u>doubt</u> or <u>uncertainty.</u> (v.5) reveals that she knew it "<u>was wrong!</u>" She wanted to Help God out, and that's always a mistake! (Rom 14:23b) says, "...for whatever is not from faith is sin." Notice that there was **No Argument from Abram!**
  - B. SINFUL <u>Produce</u> (4b-6) Abram and Sarai's plan <u>led to huge problems in the home!</u>
    - 1. Conceiving Sin (4b,5b) Things got bad when Sarai first <u>SAW</u> that conception had taken place! (Baby Bump?) Then <u>Hagar despised</u> Sarai when she **knew that she conceived Abram' Child!** Conflict arose between the women and **Abram was in the middle of it!**
    - **2.** Correcting Abram (5) Sarai ultimately <u>BLAMED</u> Abram for the Problem, "My wrong be upon you!" and "May the Lord judge..." and He does...<u>He know all our motives?</u>
    - **3.** Casting Out Hagar (6) He told her to handle however she though best (Another mistake) Sarai then mistreated Hagar so that she fled. (Gen 21:10; Gal 4:30).

P/A – God did not tell Abram and Sarai to do what they did. They were <u>acting independent of God!</u> Trying to fulfill God's promise to Abram. Their actions were <u>Fleshly Plans</u> as listed in (tt. Gal 5:19-21). – Their actions also produced a common negative phrase: Don't Birth an <u>Ishmael!</u> Which is applied to those who make decisions in the flesh. – (Gal 6:8) For he who <u>sows to his flesh</u> will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who <u>sows to the Spirit</u> will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

- Often, people try to help God, but they produce "Ishmaels." God does not need any help all He wants is your obedience. (Zech 4:6b)
- II. ESCAPE PLANS (16:7-16) Hagar's approach to Family Planning was... "I'm outta here! I'm heading back to Egypt, and I'll figure it out for myself." She decided to flee to the scene and head for the wilderness; broken, weary and lonely. Conditions that attracted divine intervention! (Expound) And so, here we see the first appearance of the mysterious "ANGEL OF THE LORD," a pre-incarnate appearance of Jesus Christ (7a).
  - **1.** HIS Interaction (7b-10) This Angel left heaven in pursuit of this one outcast, a woman! Hagar, whose very name means: "Flight," was fleeing when He found her! So, He <u>questioned her</u>, instructed her and made a <u>promises to her</u>. I find it interesting that He asked her <u>two significant questions</u>. "Where have you been?" and "Where are you going?"
    - He Directed Hagar (9) To return and submit, which required humility! (Jam 4:10)
    - **He Promised Hagar (10)** A bountiful Family Plan! *i*.e., <u>Innumerable descendants.</u>
  - 2. HIS Insight (11-12) Was prophetic, telling Her that her child was to be a *male*, and his name was to be ISHMAEL, which means "GOD WILL HEAR." The Angel revealed what was to become of Ishmael: He would be a "WILD MAN," who *causes strife with men*, and he will dwell near his brethren (Israel). Here we have the Israeli-Arab conflict!
  - **3.** Her Illumination (13-14) Apparently, <u>Hagar received and believed the Angel</u> of the Lord and *acknowledged Him as GOD!* She referred to God as, *EL-ROI* or *Jehovah Roi* which means "THE GOD WHO SEES!" She also named the well as a result.
  - **4.** Her Involvement (15-16) In obedience, Hagar returned and bore a son to Abram. God did what He had promised Hagar.

P/A – When difficulties arrive in your life are you an Escape Artist like Hagar was? Know that God Sees you and Hears you when you call on Him. (Jer 29:11 NLT), For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. – Let God take care of your Family Planning because His Plans are the best!

– On the other hand, we have **Abram and Sarai** who NOW had a son! Their **Family Planning** ... produced a son of the flesh. But God wanted to give <u>a son of promise</u>, according to...

III. GOD'S MASTER PLANS (17:1-27) — Another 13 years have passed. Abram is now 99 years-old and Sarai is 89! They had Ishmael, so they were content, but they were not expecting what God was about reveal! — (Rom 4:19b - NLT) tells us "...at about 100 years of age, he [Abram] figured his body was as good as dead—and so was Sarah's womb. — According to God's Timing... the circumstances were now ready to unveil GOD'S MASTER PLANS.

- A. God <u>REVEALS</u> (1-3) As a <u>prelude to what He was about to do</u>, God appeared to Abram and proclaimed... *I AM ALMIGHTY GOD.* {Heb. El Shaddai, i.e, <u>most powerful</u>} God first made clear that He is God of the impossible! Nothing is too difficult for God! (cf. Luke 1:37)
  - <u>God commanded that Abram</u> **WALK before God, Blamelessly,** reminding him of the covenants that were previously established. We often forget with time! (*cf.* **Deut 18:13**) <u>God desires integrity in His children!</u> That is our responsibility to keep!
  - Abram Fell on His face...to listen! (3) When was the last time you bowed to listen?
- **B.** God's <u>RENAMES</u> (4-6, 15) "As for me..." God reminds Abram of His responsibility to keep covenant with Abram and his descendants, part of which was *His promise to make him a father of many nations*. God activated this now, by changing Abrams name!
  - 1. The Lord changed Abram's name to "Abraham," and Sarai's name to "Sarah."
  - Abram = "EXALTED FATHER," whereas Abraham means "Father of a multitude" or "chief of multitude." Sarai = "PRINCESS," whereas Sarah means "Noblewoman," because she will become the mother of all nations.
  - **2.** Why did God add an "H" to their names? I am not certain, but I find it fascinating that "H" is the 5<sup>th</sup> letter in the Hebrew alphabet, the number of grace! By the Grace of God, AbraHam would be the <u>FATHER</u> of many nations.
- **C. God REAFFIRMS (7-8)** God reaffirms His <u>everlasting</u> covenant, His eternal promise to Abraham & his descendants, for perpetual generations. (300k Sq. miles promised, but only 10% claimed!) Even though they were removed from the land twice, <u>God kept the land for them!</u>
- D. God <u>REQUIRES</u> (9-14) <u>CIRCUMCISION</u>, which is the <u>surgical removal of a male's</u> foreskin. God mandated this for Abraham and all of the males in his household as a religious representation of the covenant God made with him (Gen 17:9–14; Acts 7:8).
  - 1. This Sign was to signify that <u>they were different than others</u>, i.e., distinct because <u>they depended on God</u> to fulfill the promise, **not themselves!** Unfortunately, it became *mere ritual*, to those whose hearts did not belong to God. In (**Deut 10:16**), **God rebuked** the Hebrews, "...circumcise the **foreskin** of your **heart**, and be stiff-necked no longer."
  - **2.** This sign was meant to be within their flesh (13) Later, God would desire to put a new spirit within them (Ezek 11:19-20), that they would be His people, walk in His ways. As with NT believers, we should cut-away the callous flesh from our hearts so that we can be sensitive to the things of the Spirt!
- E. God <u>REPORTS</u> (15-22) "FOUR" SURE PROMISES for Abraham's Family Plan... ha!
  - **1.** His Wife Sarah would be Blessed (15-16a) Even though the fulfillment of what He promised seems impossible, God will certainly do it! He is God ALMIGHTY! NOTE: This is the first mention of the promise that Sarah would bear a child from Abraham!

- Abraham's Response (17-18) *He fell on his face*...not for worship, but in <u>LAUGHTER</u>! Not mocking laughter, but <u>Ecstasy and Elation</u>. He was Overjoyed, but *still unclear* what the Almighty was reporting... "*Oh, that Ishmael might live...*" But God quickly made it clear in (v.19) ... NO!
- 2. His Wife Sarah would bear <u>ISAAC</u> (19) The name ISAAC means "laughter," or "he <u>laughs</u>." This is interesting, because there are <u>three different occasions of laughter</u> associated with Isaac's birth: <u>Abraham laughed for joy</u> when he heard his wife would give birth to the promised son (Gen. 17:17); <u>Sarah laughed in unbelief</u> when she heard the news (18:9–15); and <u>Sarah laughed for joy</u> when the boy was born (21:6–7).
- 3. His Son <u>ISHMAEL</u> would also be Blessed (20) God knew that Abraham loved his son Ishmael, but he was not part of the Covenant! God therefore "heard" Abraham's Angst as He did Hagar's Hurting (v.11). God <u>reported His Plan to bless</u> and multiply him.
- (Gen 25:12-18) records the 12 princes of Ishmael, who have multiplied exceedingly, even today... as promised by God! Islamic traditions consider Ishmael to be the ancestor of Arab people Muslims also believe that MUHAMMAD was the descendant of Ishmael that would establish a great nation, as promised by God in the OT.
- **4.** His Son <u>ISAAC</u> is the <u>SON OF PROMISE</u> (21-22) God emphatically declares the Covenant in with Isaac! (*Not Ishmael*). And *Isaac would be born of Sarah within a year!* Then God vanished from Abraham's presence.
- **F.** Abraham's <u>RESPONSE</u> (23-27) Abraham immediately <u>OBEYED THE LORD</u> and circumcised all of the males. This took great faith because **he was 99 yeas old!**

<u>CLOSING THOUGHT</u>: God has a perfect plan, and what He plans is the best. It may pain you to give up your cherished dreams, but <u>God's way is always the right way</u>."

- **(Prov 19:21)** There are many plans in a man's heart, Nevertheless the Lord's counsel—that will stand.
