HEAR YE, HEAR YE | LUKE 8:1-21 | PASTOR MARK BOFILL | 10/05/2025

I. Preaching Continues (1-3) | II. Parable of the Sower (4-15) | III. Parable of Reveled Light (16-18) | IV. Proving Right Relationship (19-21)

INTRO: Have you ever heard the phrase "Hear ye, hear ye?" What does it mean? It means "Listen to me!" or "Pay attention!" – It's an archaic call to introduce a public announcement or formal declaration, often associated with town criers who used it to capture the attention of the public, particularly in medieval times when many people were illiterate. – To parallel that thought, Jesus was sent to introduce the Good News of the Kingdom of God. – In our text, He Cries Out for All to Hear and All to Pay Attention: HEAR YE, HEAR YE

- I. PREACHING CONTINUES (1-3) READ: Jesus continued to Preach in Cities (v.1a) He brought "Glad Tidings" of the Kingdom of God! i.e, that all men could be Forgiven and Saved (7:50). (Don't Reject it!)
- A. He was accompanied by The Twelve (1b) The Apostles, Watching and Learning the Way of the Kingdom
- **B. He was accompanied by <u>Certain Women</u> (2-3)** They believed the <u>Message</u> and the <u>Mission</u>, so they <u>Ministered</u> to the apostolic team from *their own sustenance*. (Their sacrifice allowed help further kingdom efforts!)
 - 1. Mary Magdalene (2) Formerly demon-possessed but now devoted to her Lord!
 - 2. Joanna (3a) A woman of prominence, who had palace connections.
 - 3. Susanna and many others (3b) They all found 'The Pearl of Great Price' (tt. Matt 13:45-47) ...

P/A – *Jesus' Preaching contained* the *Message of the Kingdom of God!* – When the <u>message is heard</u> and <u>Received</u>, **His WAYS are to be followed!** – <u>These heard Jesus preach</u> and followed Him. – [segway] Now Jesus teaches a **Parable** along with an **Explanation** of <u>How To Understand Kingdom Principles</u>. He begins with...

- II. PARABLE OF THE SOWER (4-15) READ (4-8): With the emphasis of the need to hear, Jesus Presents a Parable to the large crowd (4) Durning His ministry, Jesus taught 46 parables, but this one is special because it is spiritual truth, along with the KEY to understand spiritual truths.
- A. Presenting the Parable (5-8) He tells of three important parts: The Sower, the Seed, and the Soil.
 - He Tells of <u>Four Types of Soil</u> (5b-8a): Wayside Ground (5b), Rocky Ground (6), Thorny Ground (7), Good Ground (8a) –
 - 2. He <u>Called for People to Hear!</u> (8b) Hear Ye, Hear Ye! Listen!... so as to apply it to your own life.
- P/A Does this make sense to you at the first telling of the parable? (Spiritual things are Spiritually discerned!)
- B. Objective of Parables (9-10) READ: *The disciples inquire of the meaning* (9). They wanted to understand spiritual things which is sometimes hard! So, Jesus explains <u>Two Methods of Revelation</u> (10)
 - 1. Chosen to Know (10a) God divinely called the disciples to Hear, Know, Understand. (To proclaim later!)
 - 2. <u>Choosing to Know (10b)</u> Parables Presented in a way which <u>requires a heart for spiritual development</u> Jesus does not force conversion on people. – Because <u>He Respects the Free Will</u> of each person... **Jesus Spoke in PARABLES** so that **PEOPLE** can **CHOOSE** to **HEAR** or **NOT!**
- P/A Do you desire to Know and Understand the Kingdom of God principles? (Seek... Draw me nearer Lord!)
- C. Explanation of Parables (11-15) READ: Jesus expounds on The Meaning of the Parable (11a), i.e., the Effectiveness of God's Word and its Reception. In doing so, He explains that...

- The SEED (11b) is the Word of God! (tt. 1 Pet 1:23)
- The SOWING is The Distribution of the Word of God; (it's sown) to "the ones" who receive it.
- The SOIL metaphorically describes the Hearts of men. Jesus then Expounds each Soil Type...
- 1. WAYSIDE SOIL (12) Hearts which HEAR God's Word CASUALLY! Because they don't take God's word Seriously, they Don't Respond to it! In (Matt 13:19) Jesus explains, "When anyone hears the Word of the kingdom, and does not understand, then the wicked one comes..." and like a ravenous bird, Satan immediately swoops down and snatches away the seed that was sown in the heart. (Grk. Harpazo)
 - **a.** The Roadside (12a) The seed is Exposed (Satan is aware when the Kingdom message is near)
 - **b.** The Devil (12b) The seed is Extracted (Satan works quickly to snatch it away!) People never really have a chance to devour the Word because Satan comes "To Steal, Kill, and Destroy." (John 10:10)
 - c. The Outcome (12c) The seed is <u>Extinguished</u> The devil does not want people to <u>Believe in God's</u>
 Word so <u>he removes the seed</u> before it can be <u>sown in the heart</u>. (Planted)
- **P/A We must understand that fallen mankind has Three Things** that oppose your salvation. All three are mentioned in this parable: **SATAN, SELF,** and the **Seduction of WORLD! The Workings of SATAN** is to keep you from the truth of God! **He does NOT want you to HEAR to full Gospel Truth,** lest you should come to the saving "knowledge of the truth." (1 Tim 2:3-5) Does this Soil describe your Heart?
- 2. ROCKY SOIL (13) Hearts which HEAR and Receive God's Word JOYFULLY! They Believe (for a while), but because they have no deep roots (because their Hearts are Stony) they become Shallow Christians!
 - **a.** They give into Temptation and Fall Away as a result! (Matt 13:21) says, these "endure only for a while, for when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately they stumble." (They Fall Away)
 - b. <u>Hardships</u>, <u>Tribulation</u> and even <u>Temptation</u> will come at some point in our lives. But true Christians will **PRESS ON** and <u>let the Word of God</u> **PRESS IN** <u>to our heart</u>, so it takes root! In (Acts 14:21-22), Paul 'Strengthened the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, "we must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."' (Jesus uses "these" to <u>Strengthen our faith!</u> To <u>produce mature fruit!</u>)
- **P/A This is the second thing that** opposes your salvation, and it is the Strongest: **The Weakness of SELF:** (i.e., The Lust of the Flesh, the Lust of the Eyes, and the Pride of Life) **On the contrary,** if we have "...received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, 7 rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving." (Col 2:6-7) Does this Soil describe your Heart?
- 3. THORNY SOIL (14) Those HEARTS which HEAR and Receive God's Word HALF-HEARTEDLY! The soil is good, but it is also affected by Other Things: The Cares, Riches, and Pleasures of this Life!
 - a. Thorns (14a) Metaphorically, they Wrap Around and Choke Out any potential fruit!
 - b. These... Go Out (14b) Instead of focusing on the spiritual reproduction, they look to other means for fleshly gratification. The cares, riches, and pleasures of life, are the very things that make you FRUITLESS! James says this happens when one is "...drawn away by his own desires and enticed 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death..." (James 1:14-15)
 - "CARES affect those who live in Poverty, RICHES affect those who live in PROSPERITY, and the desire for PLEASURE affects Everybody!" – Jon Coursen – Does this Soil describe your Heart?
- P/A The Way of WORLD is the third thing that <u>opposes your salvation</u>. It's attractive but we are called the narrow road (Matt 7:14) Be warned that Worldly ways will always make you Fruitless!

- 4. GOOD SOIL (15) HEARTS which HEAR God's Word and KEEP IT are considered NOBLE/HONORABLE! God' Word is Embedded within them Jesus specifies Three Key Terms that, when fulfilled, serve as PROOF OF GENUINE SALVATION:
 - a. Heard (15a) These "LISTEN" to the Word, which leads to Understanding and Belief in Jesus Christ.

 In (John 8:47a) Jesus said, "He who is of God hears God's Words..." Also (2 Tim 3:1b), the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. Hear Ye, Hear Ye!
- Keep it (15b) These "PAY ATTENTION" and respond with OBEDIENCE. They DO NOT allow <u>Satan</u>, <u>Self</u>, or the <u>Seduction of the World</u> to reduce the effectiveness of God's Word in their lives. In (John 14:21a) Jesus said, *He who has My commandments and Keeps Them, it is he who loves Me.* (it's a Responsive love!)
- c. Bear Fruit with Patience (15b) The FRUIT mentioned are good works which stem from abiding in Jesus, (John 15:5b) "He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit." Does this Soil describe your Heart?
- Matthews account mentions that: Produced Fruit will be Measured (Matt 13:23b), "...some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty." (Are you a fruitful Christian? Or are you a "for-self" Christian?)
- All accounts mention the need for PATIENCE! When planting a Garden, a farmer must be patient
 (James 5:7). The same principle applies SPRITUALLY: When God's seed is sown in our HEARTS... its
 takes <u>Time</u>, <u>Watering</u> and <u>Son-Light</u> before the first <u>Sprout</u>. Then the <u>Stem</u>, then the <u>Branch</u>... and
 in due season <u>RIGHTOEUS FRUIT...LASTING FRUIT...</u> <u>JUICY FRUIT!</u>
- As a Sower, we too can plant seeds for God's Kingdom. But all too often we become IMPATIENT, expecting immediate results. We sow the seed, but we don't allow the time! And so, we give up ... "I prayed every day this week and nothing happened", "I gave up such and such and nothing has changed!"
- **BE PATIENT!** If your heart is **GOOD SOIL**, then the **HOLY SPIRIT** will supernaturally produce the <u>Good Fruit</u>, <u>Abundant Fruit</u>... <u>Juicy Fruit</u> in your life!
 - Those among the Roadside are Exposed to the Word, but it's Stolen away
 - Those among Stony places are Excited about the Word, but they Fall away!
 - Those among Thorns are Engrossed with the Word, but Choked by the world, bearing Fruitless ways!
- P/A The Parable of the Sower makes people think, "What kind of soil am !?" It challenges each listener to <u>nurture the soil of their heart</u>, so that **God's message has the greatest impact** on their lives.
- III. PARABLE OF REVEALED LIGHT (16-18) READ: <u>Jesus provides this Parable to teach on the Hearer's RESPONSIBILITY to the Word.</u> If we have heard it, then we need to...
- A. Proclaim it Openly (16-17) Remember the old children's song ,'This Little Light of Mine?' It goes on to say... Hide it under a bushel... NO! ... I'M GONNA LET IT SHINE! If you have the Truth of God, you have a sacred obligation to share His message in any way God provides you the chance!
 - 1. Light Displayed (16) A LAMP is only a holder, but the LIGHT is what needs to be seen! In ancient times, Lamps sat in or on a place where the Light is clearly seen. The Light is the Gospel (cf. 2 Cor 4:4).
 - 2. Light Reveals (17) Jesus says there is Nothing Secret. Sooner or later the secrets we thought we could keep are brought out in the open. God will expose them for everyone to see at the judgment to come.
 - And so, with our Christian faith, it is NOT some private or hidden thing... it is designed to be Open,
 Public, and Bright. In fact, <u>True Christians SHINE like Jesus</u> in this dark world.
 - What sort of things would God have you bring "out into the open?" (Expose it or be exposed!)

B. Practice it Faithfully (18) – Now Jesus speaks of ACCOUNTABILITY to the Word. He says..."Take heed how you hear!" – When we Truly Hear the Word of God, and receive it with gladness, more will be given to us from God's spiritual riches. – But many people assume spiritual enlightenment (like the Pharisees), who were "seemingly" rich spiritually. – But like the Church of Laodicea, they do "Not Know that they were wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked." – Jesus makes clear that even what these seem to have will be TAKEN AWAY!

P/A – HEAR YE, HEAR YE Church! Jesus wants each of us to have Fertile Hearts to receive the seed. But He also want us to be a Sower of seeds. – The fruit of sharing the Gospel doesn't just happen on its own. It takes a humble heart and meditation on the Word of God to produce a good harvest and to further the Kingdom of God. (Shine your Light!)

IV.PROOF OF RIGHT RELATIONSHIP (19-21) – READ: As this circumstance arises, Jesus uses it to emphasize the point that He had already been making: i.e., Hearing and Following Jesus' Word demonstrates our Right Relationship with Him.

A. Petitioning Jesus (19-20) – Jesus' Mother already believed in Jesus, but His half-brothers failed to believe in Him at this point, (cf. John 7:3-5; Mark 3:21). They used their special privilege card to access Jesus!

B. Proclamation of Jesus (21) – "My [REAL] mother and My brothers are these who hear the word of God and do it." – Whoa! Jesus' answer to the messengers could be interpreted as offensive to some! (disrespectful). –

- But we must understand that **He wasn't being RUDE**, but rather **SPIRTUAL!**
- <u>Jesus always prioritized the Spiritual first</u> because Kingdom laws [and relationships] are spiritual. This does not means that He didn't allow them access, but He wanted the messengers and those around Him to know what validates a Right Relationship... Hearing and Doing the Word of God!

CLOSING THOUGHTS: And so, Jesus' teaching in this section emphasized **HEARING!** – **HEAR YE, HEAR YE...**

Four questions bases on the four points:

- 1. Are you one who follows Jesus? Offering Him you time and resources.
- 2. What is the Condition of your Heart? Is it Fertile or is it a Fault-line!
- 3. How do you respond to the Light? Do you Show it or Blow it out?
- 4. Is your relationship with Jesus questionable... or is it Spiritual?

(2 Cor 9:10) Now may <u>He who supplies seed to the sower</u>, and bread for food, <u>supply and multiply the seed you have sown</u> and increase the fruits of your righteousness!
