Definition Of Idolatry –


Webster - The worship of a physical object as a god immoderate attachment or devotion to something

4. The things I serve, are the things my kids may serve | Proverbs 22:6, Joshua 24:14-15

Our kids are always watching us | you and your kids don't have to fall into the same generational trap|

Deal with the high places | 1 Kings 11:1-7

Solomon began to compromise | Putting away sin or idols doesn't mean that we just get out of the way so our kids cannot touch it, it means throwing it away | Deal with the high places in our life and tear them down.

5. We tend to serve things from a place of status quo | John 5:1-8, Romans 12:1-2

We have just come to accept our brokenness and bondage| Jesus came to change the status quo| It is time to get up of the place you have been in and go into a place of freedom| God is calling you to take your status quo life and give it to Him
