3. What Is Deliverance? It's Scriptural and Simple

Reject: Make a choice to refuse any presence or influence of evil.

Renounce: Turn away from past involvement with occult practices or sin.

Rebuke: Speak a direct command in the name of Jesus for the spirit to leave.

Fill: Pray for the Holy Spirit to fill the person afterward so they remain grounded.

Homework: - * DO THIS DAILY IN PREPARATION OF TOTAL VICTORY

1. Ask the Lord Jesus for forgiveness and to help you walk in freedom
2. Everyday confess Jesus as your personal Lord and your personal Savior to everyone you come in contact with, Make It Plain
3. Open clear communication with the Lord through prayer (talking with Him)
4. As the week goes by confess every sinful act and thought as they come or happen.
5. Begin collecting (writing down and even memorizing) scriptures you can use as ammunition against your flesh and the devil as they come
6. Go to those who have wronged you or you have wronged and ask for forgiveness (if possible). Let everything you hold against others, let it go. (Eliminate all door stops)
7. Begin to look at everything and everyone with a humble and thankful heart
8. Ask the Lord to help identify areas of sin and or the occult that have doors open to demonic or fleshly control.
9. Ask the Lord to lead you by His Spirit, ask Him to fill you with His Spirit ask for the fulness of His Spirit to be activated in you through fruit and to operate in the gifts of His supernatural Spirit daily.
10. Expel all and relinquish all control of evil spirits at work in your life and command them to leave because of the authority of Jesus who now works in you!

NINE STEPS TO DELIVERANCE

"Do not feel bound to this prayer pattern. If the Holy Spirit prompts you to add words from your heart, do not hesitate to add them as you're praying. Do not be in a hurry. Go through the whole prayer slowly and carefully."

1. Personally affirm your faith in Christ:

"Lord Jesus Christ, I believe You are the Son of God and the only way to God – that you died on the cross for my sins and rose again so that I might be forgiven and receive eternal life."

2. Humble yourself:

"I renounce all pride and religious self-righteousness and any dignity that does not come from you. I have no claim on Your mercy except that You died in my place."

3. Confess any known sin:

"I confess all my sins before You and hold nothing back. Especially I confess _____"

4. Repent of all sins:

"I repent of all my sins. I turn away from them and I turn to You, Lord, for mercy and forgiveness."

5. Forgive all other people:

"By a decision of my will, I freely forgive all who have ever harmed or wronged me. I lay down all bitterness, all resentment and all hatred. Specifically, I forgive _____"

6. Break with the occult and all false religion :

"I sever all contact I have ever had with the occult or with all false religion – particularly _____"

"I commit myself to get rid of all objects associated with the occult or false religions."

7. Prepare to be released from every curse over your life :

"Lord Jesus, I thank You that on the cross You were made a curse, that I might be redeemed from every curse and inherit God's blessing. On that basis I ask You to release me and set me free to receive the deliverance I need."

8. Take your stand with God:

"I take my stand with You, lord, against all Satan's demons. I submit to You, lord, and I resist the devil. Amen!"

9. Expel:

"Now I speak to any demons that have control over me. **[Speak directly to them].** I command you to get out from me now. In the name of Jesus I expel
