Practice Being a Christian, Practice Coming Out of Your Shell, Practice Sharing Your Faith At Bible Study, Practice Sharing Your Testimony, Practice Being Kind To Others, Practice Sharing Your Fruit, **Practice Praying For Strangers**, Practice Giving While Expecting Nothing In Return. Practice Being A Family, Giving!

People are a Christians or Are Not a Christian For Two Reasons!#1 They Have Met A Person Who Calls Themselves A Christian - Set Up For Failure
#2 They Have Met A Person They Perceive Is A Christian - They Were Called Christians!

5. Reception May Be the Issue: Can They Hear Him?

Specific type of prayer mentioned in the Bible:

- 1. Tthanksgiving Philippians 4:6 "with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God."
- 2. Prayer of Worship. In Acts 13:2-3
- 3. Intercession. (1 Timothy 2:1). In John 17
- 4. The Prayer of Faith. In James 5:15 we read, "And the prayer of faith"
- 5. Corporate prayer. The early church "all joined together constantly in prayer" (Acts 1:14 NIV) and was devoted to prayer together (Acts 2:42). While praying alone is an important part of Christian growth, praying together serves a unique role that combines the power of prayer with community among believers.
- 6. Prayer of Consecration. Jesus is our example in this area. On the night before His death, He prayed, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will" (Matthew 26:39).

In Conclusion: These and others types of prayer all acknowledge our complete dependence upon the Lord's help for our daily needs. The Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:9-13 offers a model prayer we can also use in praising and making our requests known to God.
