Accusations and our answers

What accusations is the enemy speaking to you? And what is your weapon to speak to the storm? When the enemy comes in like a flood, He will raise a standard against it. What's your standard? And what is your offensive weapon?

1). Accusation: I have no purpose. God can't use me.

Response: **Ephesians 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

2). Accusation: I don't believe God can love me.

Response: **Romans 8:39-39** For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

3). Accusation: God won't be there to help me when I need Him.

Response: **Isaiah 41:10** Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

4). Accusation: People have failed me, God will too.

Response: **Hebrews 10:23** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

5). Accusation: I've lost my hope.

Response: **Romans 15:13** Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

6). Accusation: I'll always lose in the end.

Response: **Romans 8:37** Yet in all of these things we are more than conquerors through Him

who loved us. **Philippians 4:13** I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength.

7). Accusation: There's no end to my circumstances. This will never end.

Response: **Hebrews 6:19** We have this hope as an anchor for our souls. **Psalms 30:5** Weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning.

8). Accusation: I'm afraid of everything.

Response: **II Timothy 1:7** For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of love, power and a sound mind.

9). Accusation: I'm too young for God to use me.

Response: **I Timothy 4:12** Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

10). Accusation: God isn't good cause bad things happen to me and to people around me.

Response: **Psalms 46:1-3** God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; though its waters roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with its swelling. Selah.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.
