We see a church of people that are filled with the Holy Spirit. We see a church of people that love God with all of their heart, soul, mind, and strength, and love each other and their brothers and sisters around the world, with the love of Christ.

1. How you "walk" is how you live, how you behave, how you conduct yourself.

2. To walk by the Spirit is to <u>continually surrender</u> to the Holy Spirit as He leads you out of sin and into holiness.

3. The sin nature is <u>against</u> what the Holy Spirit wants, and the Holy Spirit is <u>against</u> what the sin nature wants. **vs. 17**

4. To walk by the Spirit, I forsake the sin listed in vs. 19-21 and embrace the holiness listed in vs. 22-23.

How do I recognize the leading of the Spirit?

1. The flesh leads you to sin; the Spirit leads you to holiness. Galatians 5:19-23

2. The flesh leads you to selfishness, and the Spirit leads you to love God and others. Mark 12:29-31

3. The flesh leads you to bitterness, anger, and <u>division</u>; the Spirit leads you to forgiveness, <u>peace</u>, and reconciliation. Galatians 5:19-23, Ephesians 4:1-6, 29, Hebrews 10:23-25

4. The flesh leads you to reject Scripture; the Spirit leads you to embrace it. Psalm 119:105

5. To recognize the leading of God's Spirit, fill your mind with God's Word. 2 Timothy 3:16
