E-mail from our Global Partners in France Alain and Carol Larrey

Dear Friends in Christ,

So, what's been going on here in August...? One day a man from the village soccer team called to say that he was having a visit from his sister from the other end of the country and that she remembered meeting Alain years ago at an annual "Easter Monday picnic" organized by a church in the area. She then came to the phone and explained that she's joined an evangelical church where she lives now, in Annecy. She was visiting her brother, not because of summer vacation, but because they were very concerned that maybe their mother was near the end. A few days later Alain got a call to come on over. He thought it was to meet the sister in person, but no, she wasn't there. Serge was alone and greeted him with questions on spiritual things. As it wasn't the first time sharing the Gospel with him, this time Alain opted to present the "Four Spiritual Laws." Looks like the Lord is working on this man's heart. Praise the Lord for his sister who is sharing the faith with him too. P.S. Their mother is doing better and has been placed in a rest home.

We gave some children's Bible story and coloring/activity books to Alain's sister for her to share the faith with her grandchildren. We hope that Camille, whose brain tumor prevents her often from being able to concentrate, will be drawn by the pictures and benefit from these as well. Last week while visiting, Alain was alone with her for a good hour. Camille, who usually doesn't try to talk or pay much attention to what is being said in a group situation, was having "a good day" and was even responsive as Alain spoke of salvation.

The Basque New Testaments have all been given out, and from what I hear they were "accepted politely." May the Lord use them to touch hearts!

Marie and Eddy, a couple who have been very involved in church ministries, have moved to Angola for a three-year term with Eddy's job. Pray for their safety (especially this week with the elections). Pray that the Lord would quickly fill the hole (more like a chasm!) they leave in the church (coordinating the musicians, sound-system, YouTube recordings, etc, etc, etc...)!

Please bring a treat to share; water and soda will be provided.



Sign Up for Dinner for Six

Do you want an opportunity to connect with other people from Trinity? We are organizing groups of people who will meet up for dinner. It's called "Dinner for Six." To participate, you sign up for a three-month period, and you will be organized by the church office into groups. You agree to host dinner one time during the three-month period at your home or another place (see FAQ below), providing the entrée. The other times, you bring either the salad/rolls or the veggie/dessert (determined by the host). This is a great way to get to know other people in a more casual setting.

- ♦ What if I can't host where I live? There are a few options for you. If the weather is good, you could meet at a park if it is manageable for the others in the group. You could meet at a restaurant, but it would be best to check that it is affordable for other people. You could also host it at church in the Fellowship Hall/Patio if it is available and if you clean up completely after the event is done.
- ◆ This seems like a couples thing and I'm single. Can I participate? Of course! We will be designing the groups with the available people to make a group as close to six people as possible.
- ♦ What dates are we meeting? Our first suggested meeting for Dinner for Six is Sunday, September 11th. We will suggest other dates for the other months but if your group can't meet then, pick another date during the month.
