E-mail from our Global Partners in France Alain and Carol Larrey

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last Sunday we were blessed as we listened to five testimonies followed by baptisms. Nelly, 47, and her husband Olivier, 48, each had things they really wanted to say. Nelly had learned to love the Lord growing up in the church of Pau then moved on to Paris. She gave several examples of the Lord's miraculous protection in her life. The last one mentioned was when the Lord answered prayers concerning her husband's job which allowed them to move back to Pau. That was several years ago. Since then they both would often talk about baptism but couldn't quite get to it. Recently their 12-yr-old son spoke up: "well, why don't you just do it?!" That's what did it! One extra thing motivated Olivier, a school administrator (responsible for 900 students with the help of 100 teachers), because he sees all the children in the church and wants to organize Sunday school!

Several Christian parents were encouraged by what Maxime shared. After being brought up in the church, he had gone to see what the world had to offer. Here he is coming back at age 29 with a profound assurance as to why he believes.

Beatriz is the 19-year-old daughter of the Brazilian family mentioned in previous letters. Her radiant smile alone testifies of the big change in her life. She shared how she was just miserable when her parents divorced. Her dream was to get away and study in the US. Then her father remarried with a charming, loving Christian woman. The family came to France to set Beatriz up at the university and managed to stay for a few years during which time they met Christians and followed them to our church. Here the father and Beatriz both came to know and deeply love the Lord. Her father and stepmother had to return to Brazil when their visas ran out. We are so glad that Beatriz can continue her studies in Pau and stay on with us!

Then there's David. He was brought up in a Protestant family who baptized him when he was just a few days old. "I can't really say that I was a believer before being baptized" he chuckled. He, too, told of wandering away to see what the world had to offer. Here he is at age 40 wanting to clearly proclaim his faith by being baptized as an adult.

Thank you for praying... Virginie feels good in her place of practical training in Toulouse and is able to come 120 miles back to Pau every other weekend. Antoine is 60 miles in the opposite direction, Angresse, a village on the Atlantic coast; he thinks he'll be able to keep accompanying hymns almost every weekend.

Prayer request: for the exceptional board meeting October 3rd. Thirteen have asked for membership and don't want to wait for the annual meeting in March. Why? Because the bylaws state that only members can get involved in the church's ministries, especially in teaching. Since this meeting was announced, others have called hoping it's not too late to be added to the list. This is an amazing dynamic that some see as a reaction to months of confinement... the Lord has been active "behind the scenes."

So yes, restrictions have let up. Worship services, Bible studies, prayer meetings, and youth groups are held almost like beforehand. Just need to wear masks, and fist bumps replace kisses of greeting!

We got to spend time with Alain's niece, Camille whose health is steadily declining. She managed to get out of bed that day, wander out to the dining room and talk a little bit. Such a sweetheart... several times she stood up and held on to the table to remain standing. Someone would ask "where are you going?" She had seen her mom go to the kitchen and she wanted to help! Finally she would sit again and try to eat a mouthful or two. We continue to pray for the salvation of each member of the family.
