Dear Friends in Christ.

Restrictions have been pretty much lifted, giving a very unique feeling of "freedom." For the worship service, we must continue wearing masks but can be seated closer together. When the weather permits, groups of 10 can picnic together. Very few of our church people have come down with the virus, but those who have had it, haven't forgotten their experience and remind us to be prudent. In May, Alain and I got a first dose of the Pfizer vaccine; the second is scheduled for June.

At the rest home, where our friend Claude is, sanitary measures are no longer applied. Covid has passed through, everybody has been sick, and quite a few rooms are free. Claude came through okay, just naturally weakening with age.

We had asked for prayer, and yes, we have two new "anciens" (elders) to strengthen the church leadership, George and Benjamin. During the worship service on May 9th, both gave their testimony and the assembly prayed for their ministries. That following week, George had a terrible accident with bleach at his mother's house. In the emergency room, the doctors were sure his sight was lost and lined up an operation ASAP which could only be the next day. A note was sent out to the church members, and we all prayed. When the time came for the operation, the ophthalmologist was astonished. George's eyes were much better. The operation was postponed with the hope that his eyes would continue healing with just the ointment. And they did! Already, this last Sunday, George was back in church without any bandages whatsoever and praising God he could see!

One last piece of good news... Three have asked for baptism! Olivier, Nelly and Maxime... Maybe September.

Thank you again and again for your support and prayers, for ourselves and the Lord's work in Pau!
